Students in Chef Zone class prepare delicious fruit and granola breakfast power bowls to keep them energized. Who said healthy food can't be ono?



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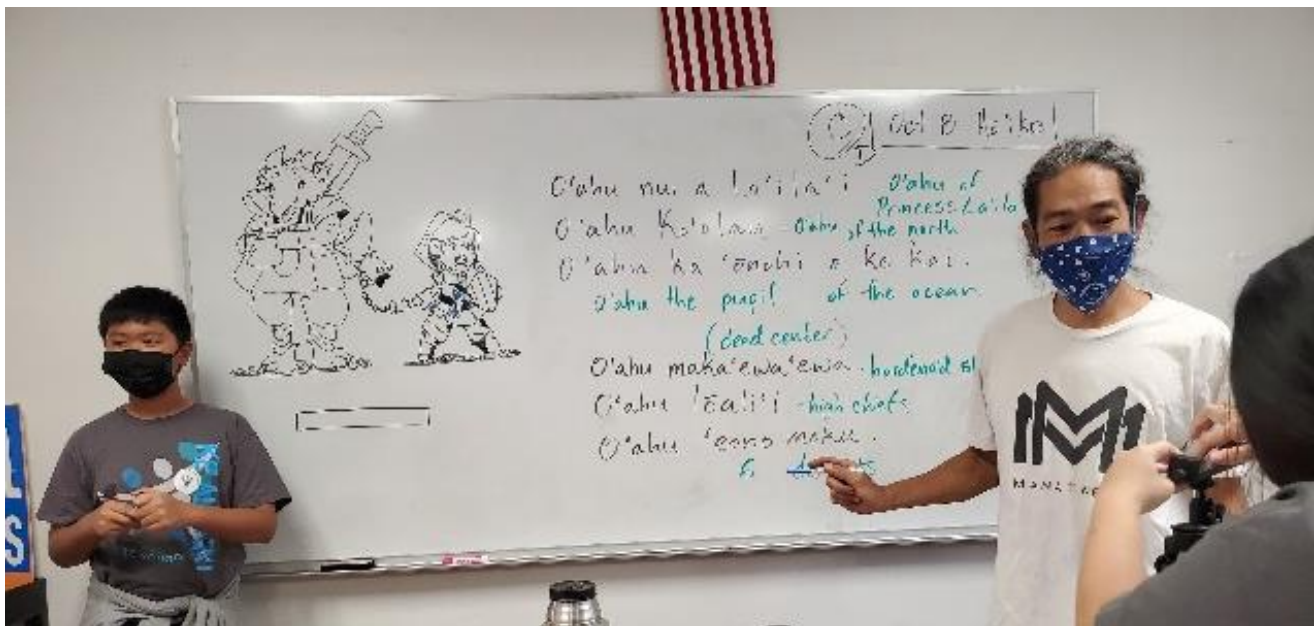

Taking a break from learning to play 'ukulele, Kumu Nakama from Mana Mele teaches All-Star students mele Hawai'i.

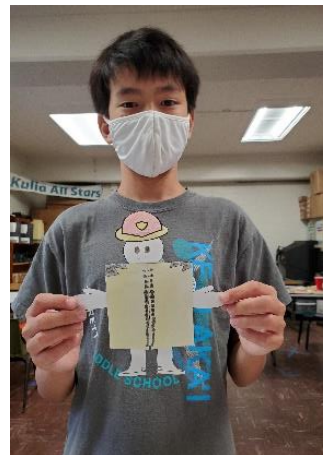
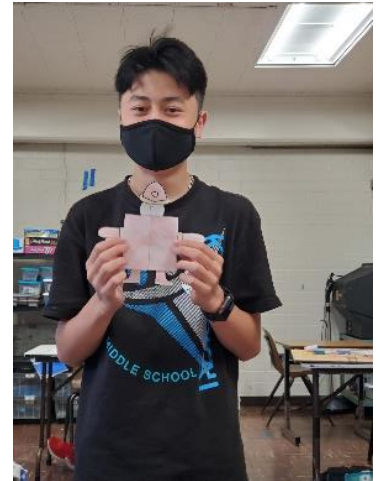
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SERVICE LEARNING PROJECT

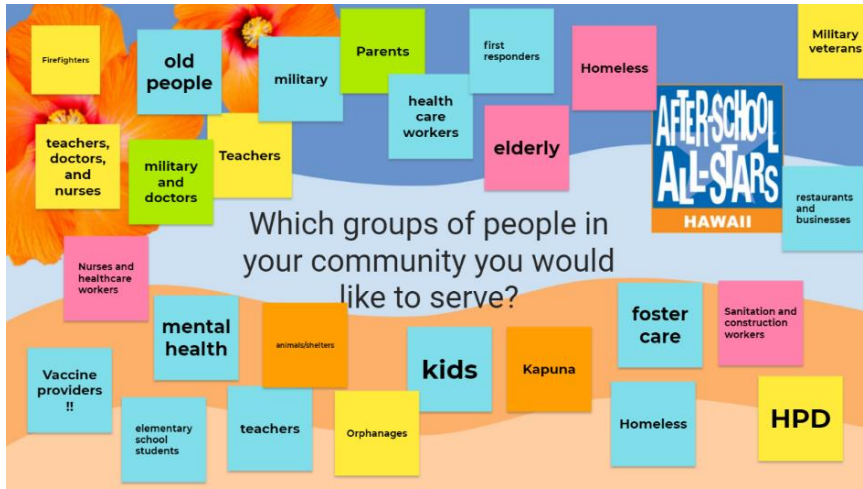
