Staff came in over the break to work on lesson plans for the next quarter, as well as learn how to improve as Program Leaders.

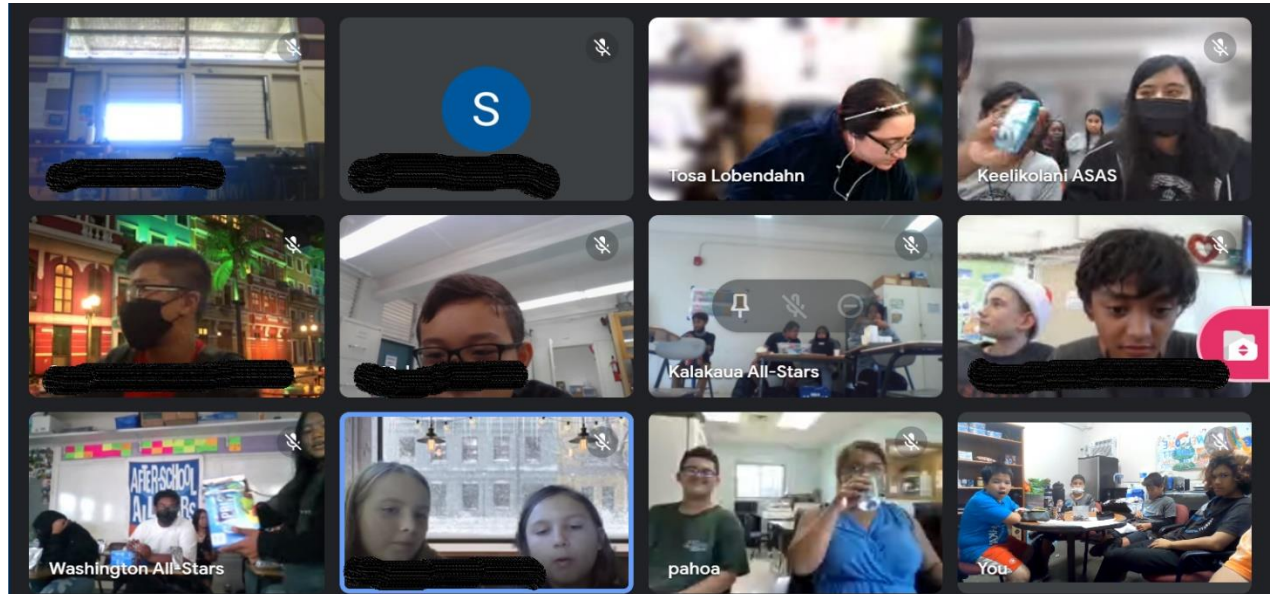
