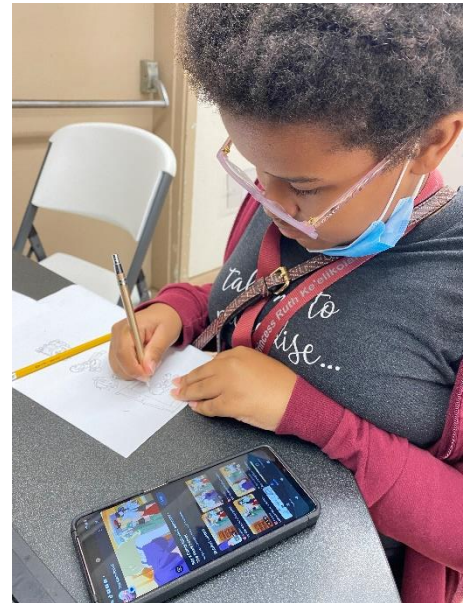


It's delicious!

Hip Hop dance class is high energy and fun. Stretching is a critical element, as well as an dynamic teacher like Ms. Queenie. Come dance with us!



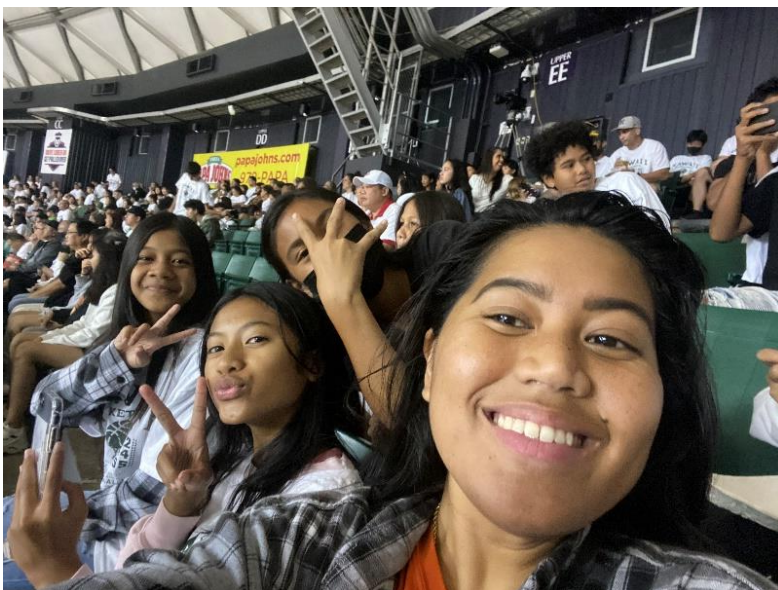

UH BASKETBALL GAME



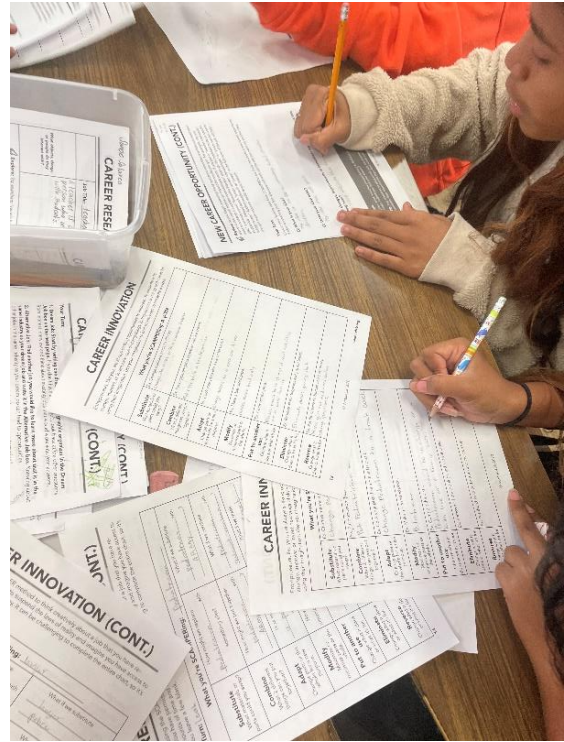
