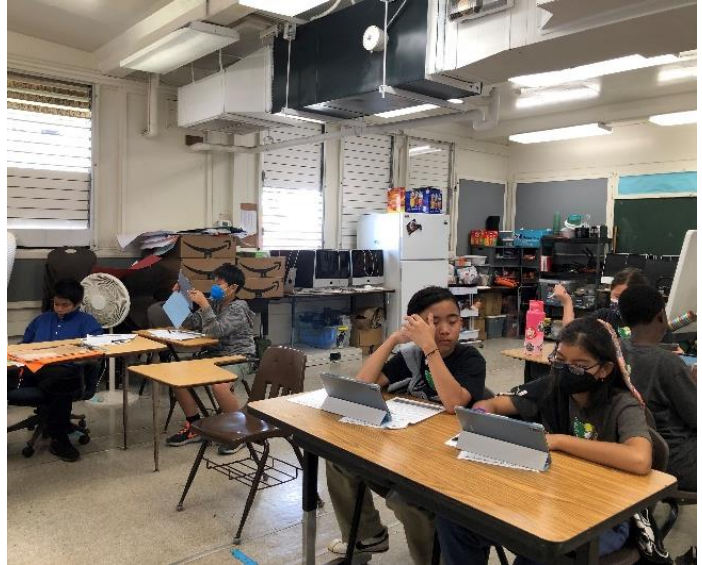
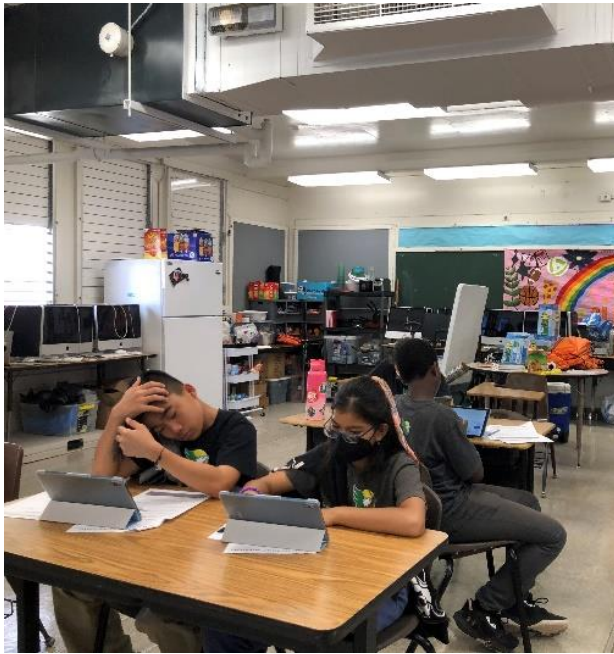
Art classes have allowed students to express themselves and relieve any stress from their day.

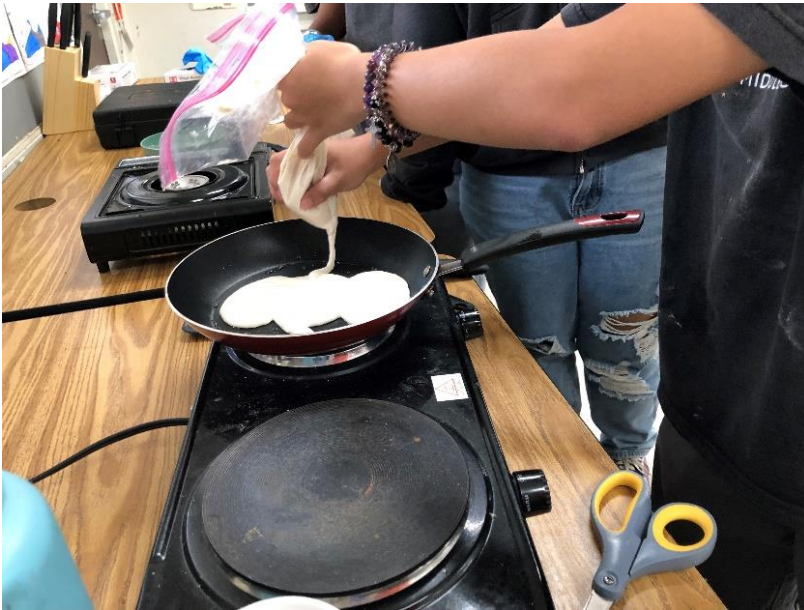

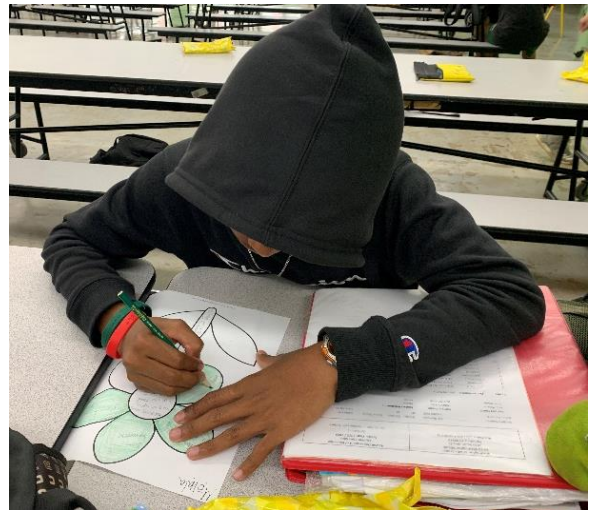

For the STEM activity, the students pushed paper to its limits as they competed to see who could stack the most books on foundations of paper.



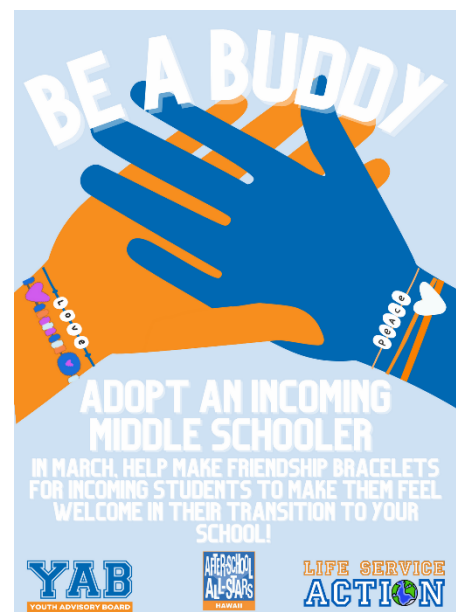
