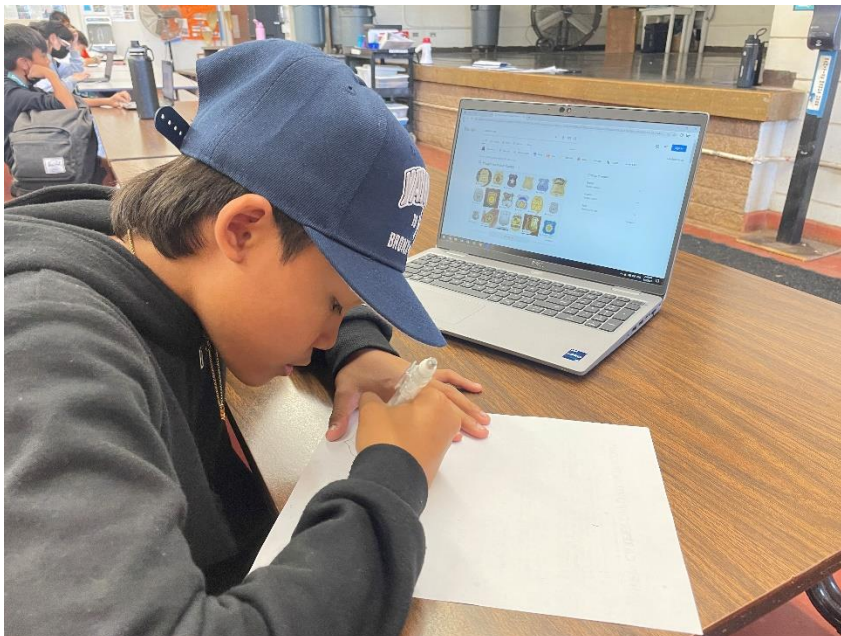
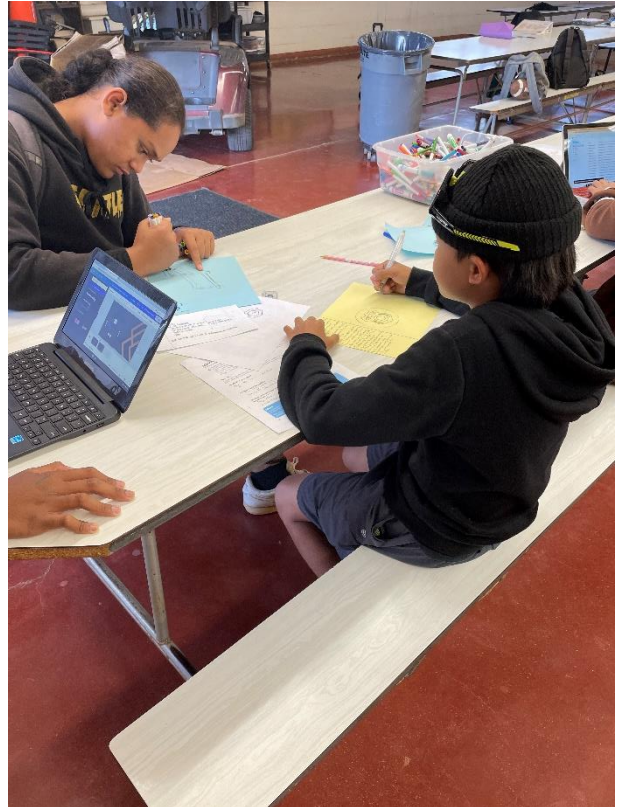


Volleyball is very popular at Kalākaua All-Stars. Even though the season has ended, the students work on passing, serving and setting drills. The team will be ready for the next season.

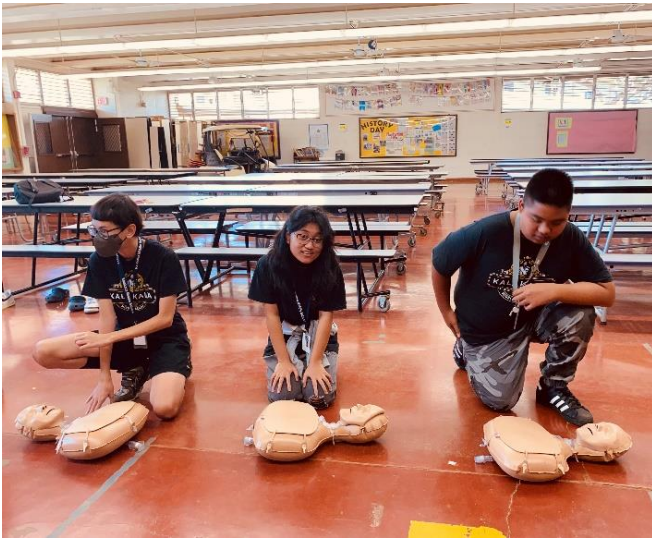

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KUALOA RANCH FIELD TRIP



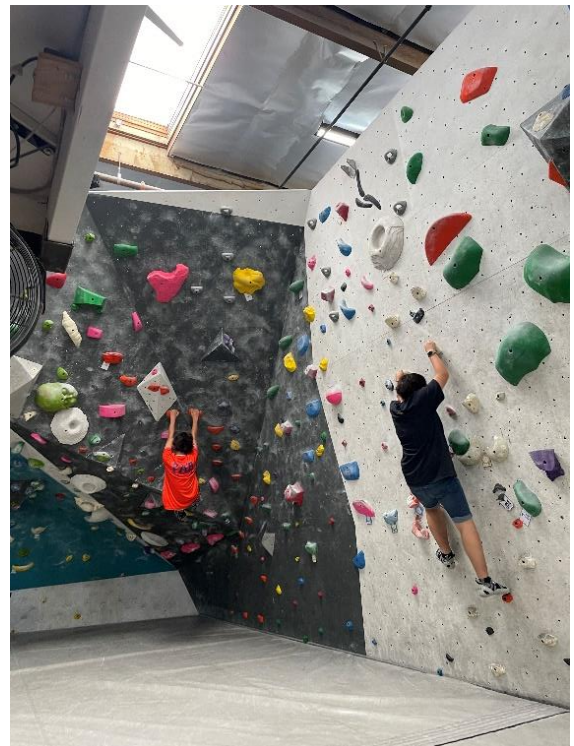

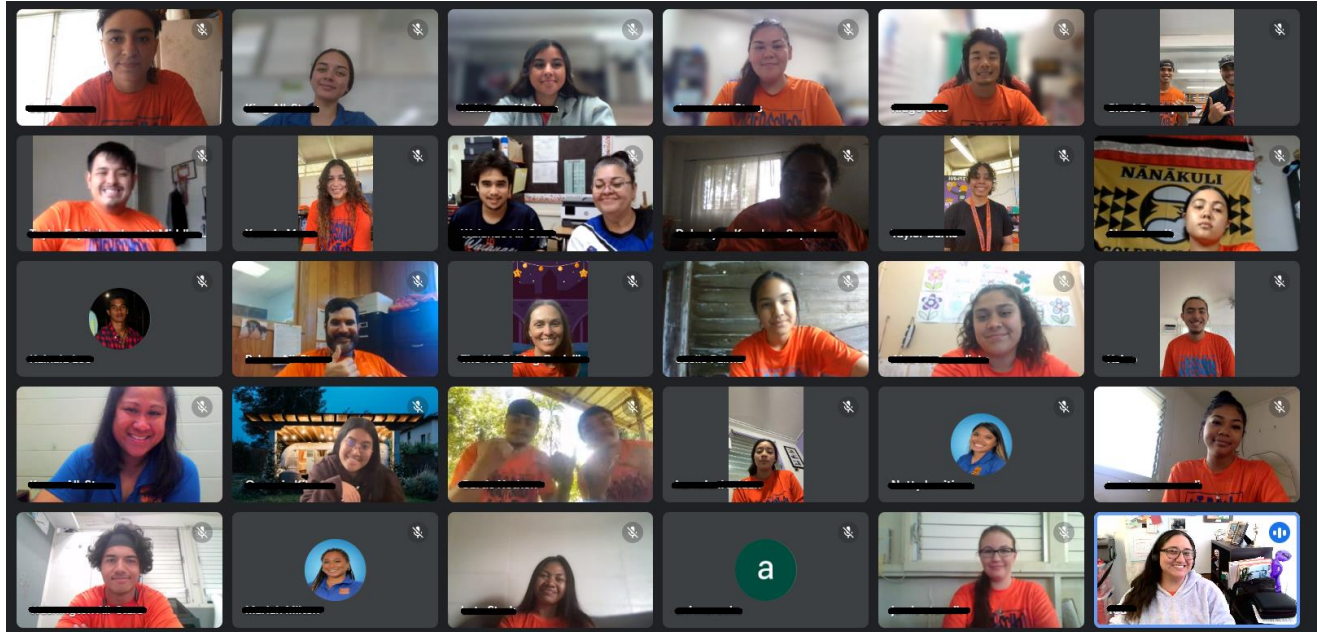




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STAFF TRAININGS
