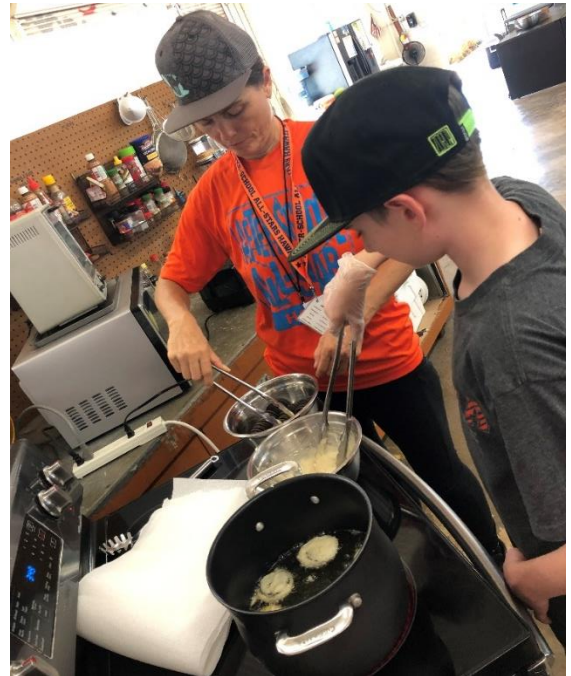
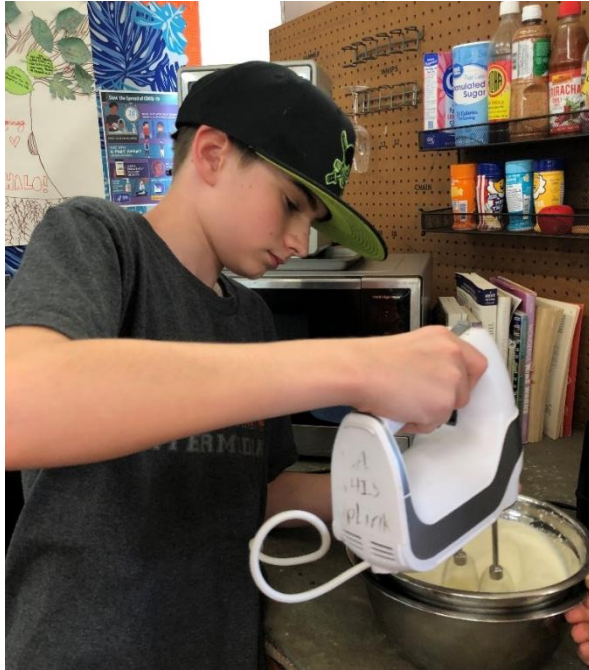


In Quarter 4, we introduce our After-School All-Star Softball League. Our Waialua Bulldogs practiced their throwing and catching in preparation for our April games.

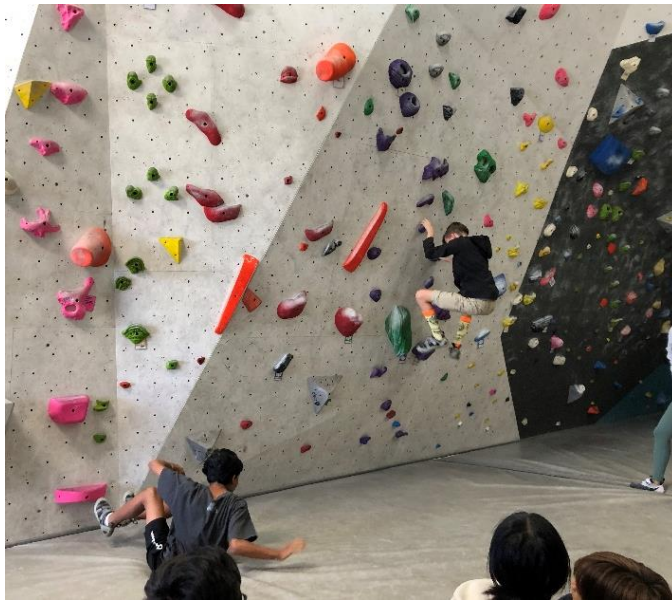
Who doesn't love a sweet treat every once in a while? Fried Oreos are a great way to end the week. All you need is some pancake mix and your favorite cookies.

In March, All-Stars students banded together to make friendship bracelets for the incoming 7<sup>th</sup> grader, to make sure they feel welcome at their new school.





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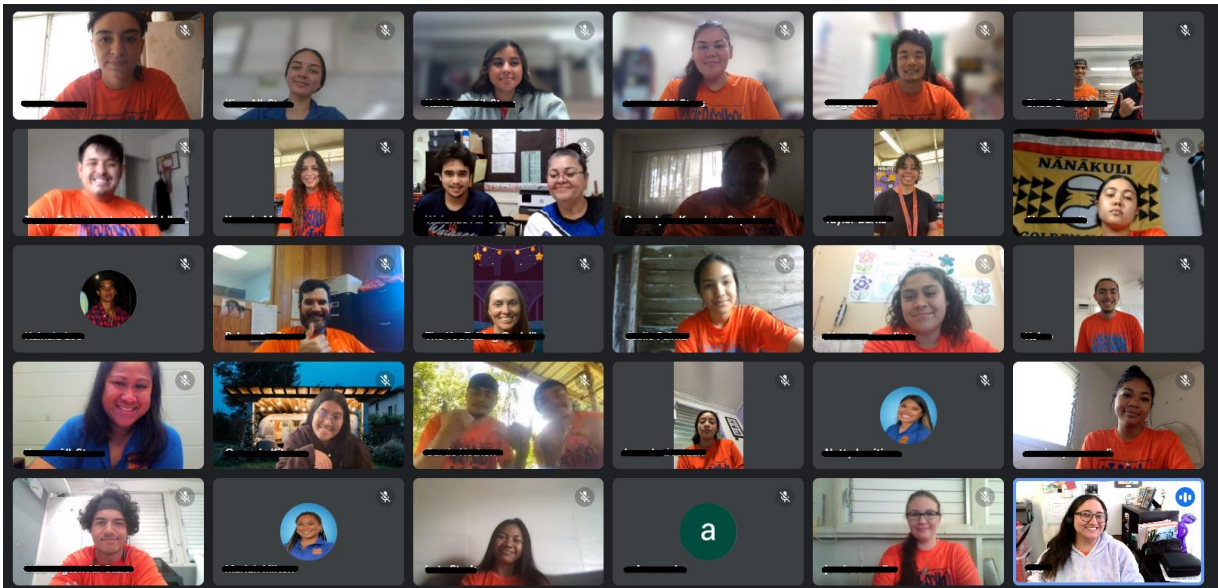
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### FIELD TRIPS
