Movies and Bowling are always a hit with our students. Students were able to watch the new Spiderman movie and try out the new Hyper Bowl game at Aiea Bowl.

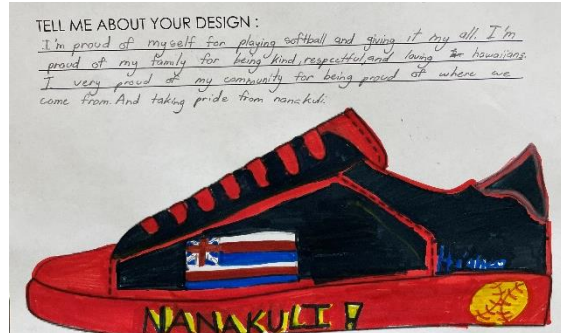
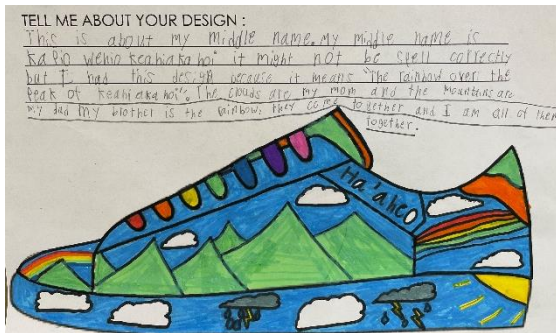


HAWAIIAN VALUE OF THE WEEK AND CLAN WARS
