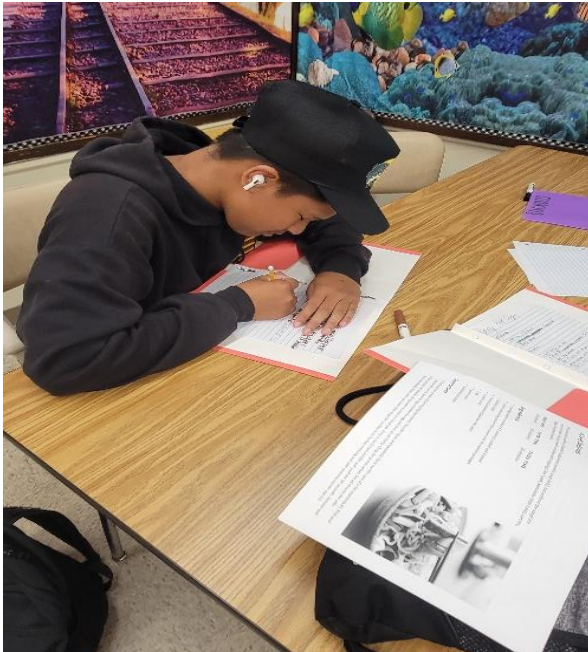
# JUNE 2023



It all begins here. From ball control to defense, skills and, we must not forget, shooting for accuracy as Program Leaders take students through the basics of basketball.

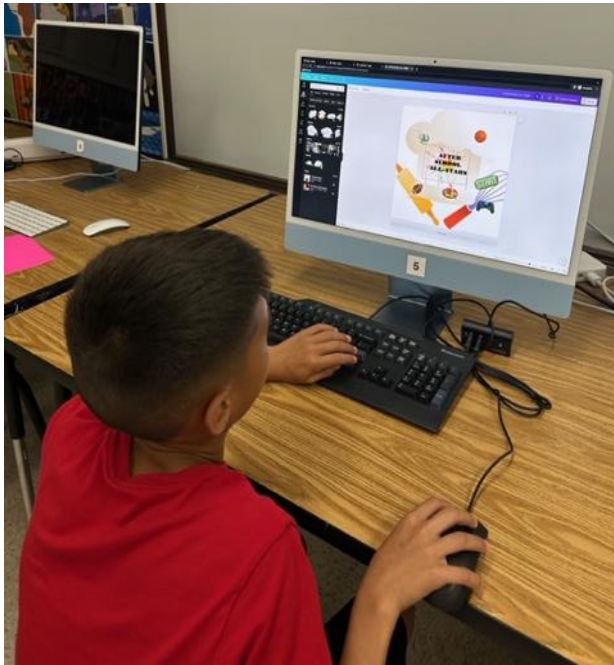






Students use time to write recipes down so they may be able to replicate what they learned during class, at home. Today students cooked up some ono fried noodles.

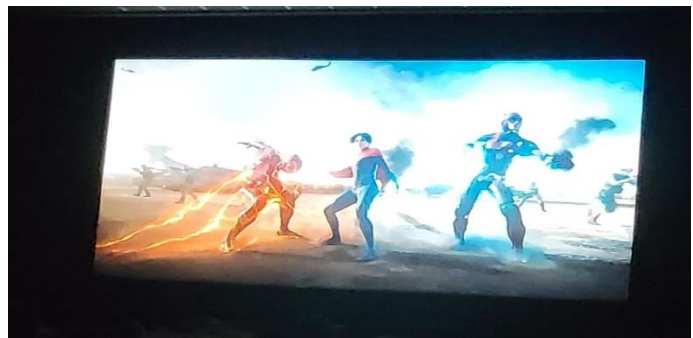
