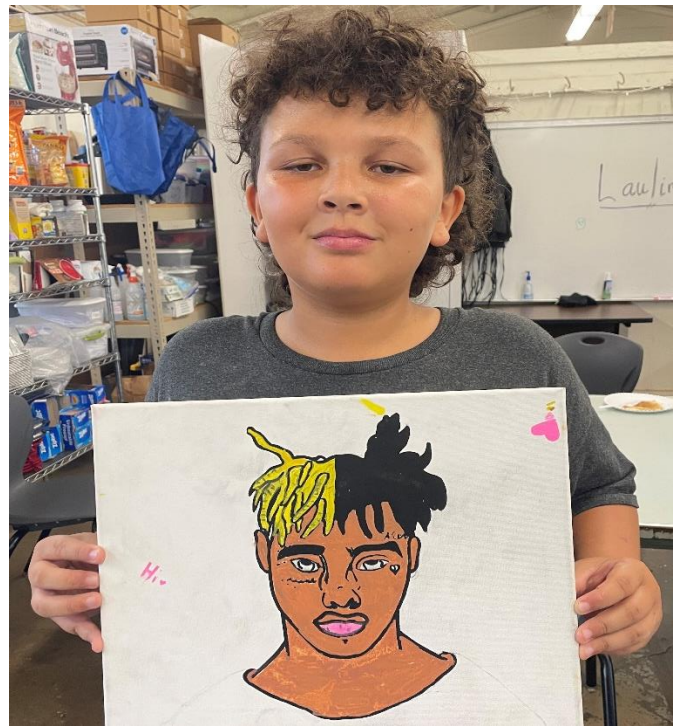
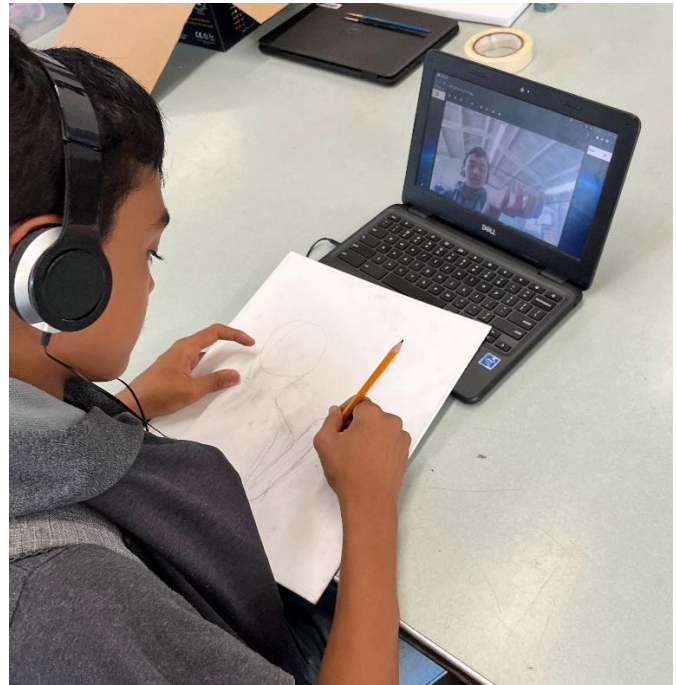
CLASSES

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The *Cooking Class* makes chicken katsu and freshly squeezed lemonade.



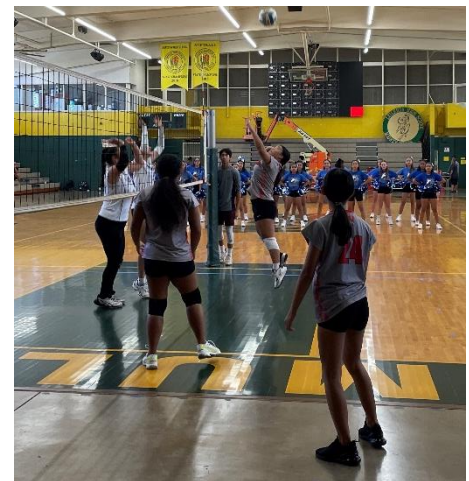
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FIELD TRIPS
