Basketball

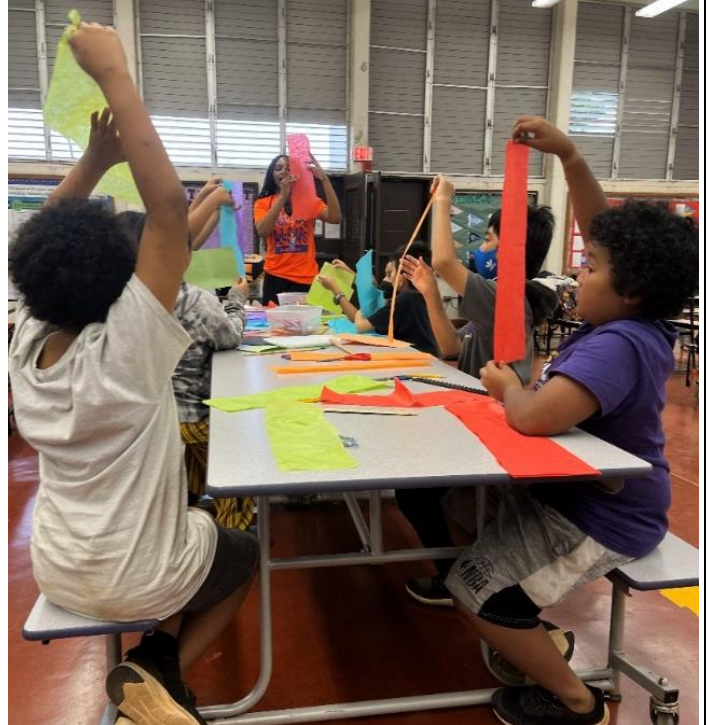

Juice Jam and Cooking Class



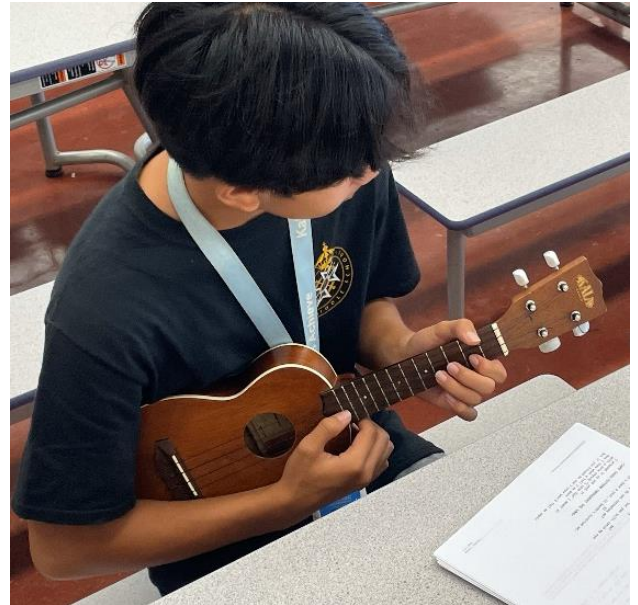
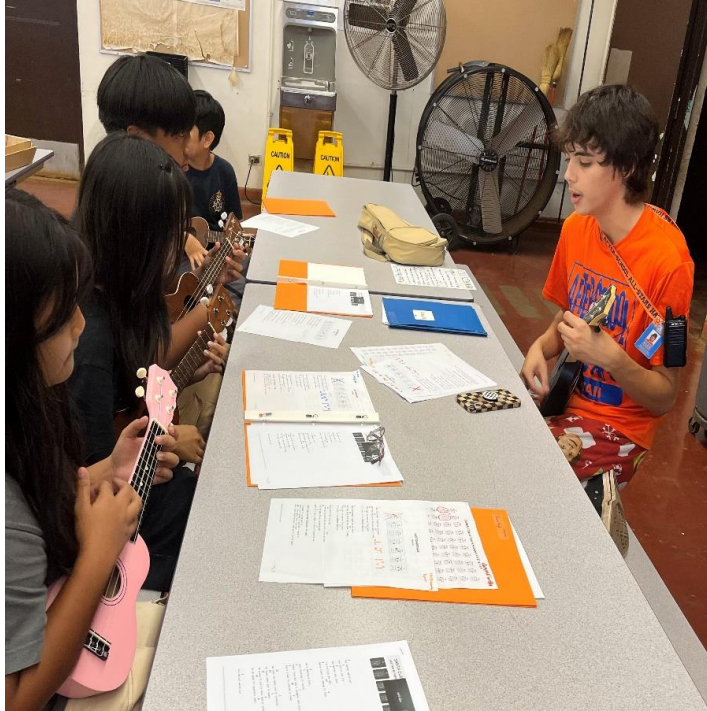
