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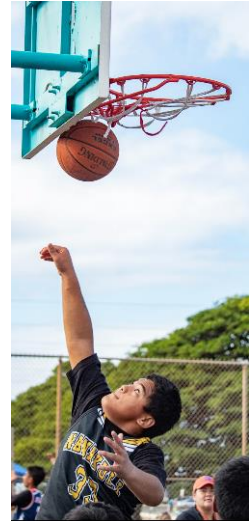

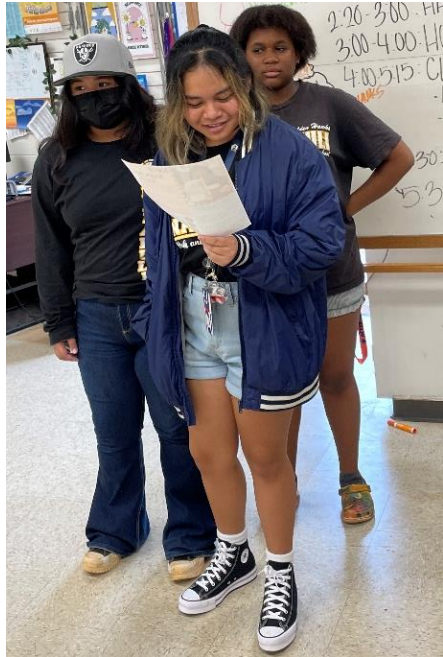
Nanakuli staff delivered Thank You Roses, our students made to Sack N Save employees. It was so awesome to see the smiles on the grocery store workers faces.



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YOUTH ADVISORY BOARD

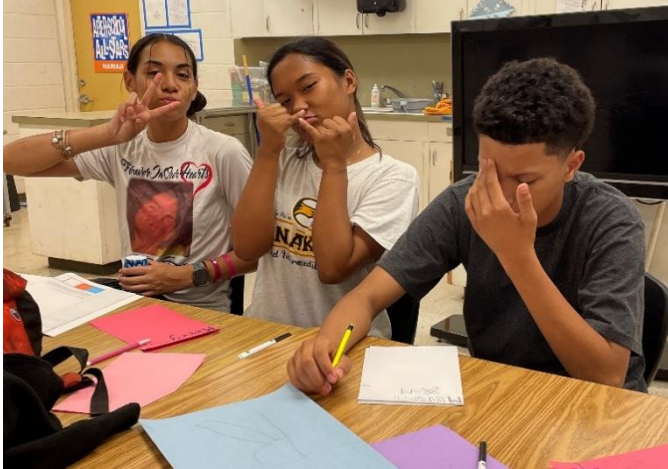

Nanakuli All-Stars made Christmas cards for local kupuna and had a great time being creative and bringing Christmas cheer.



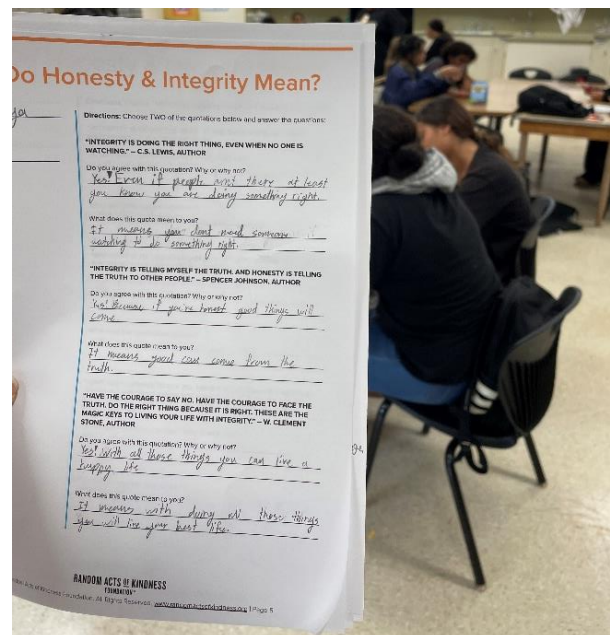
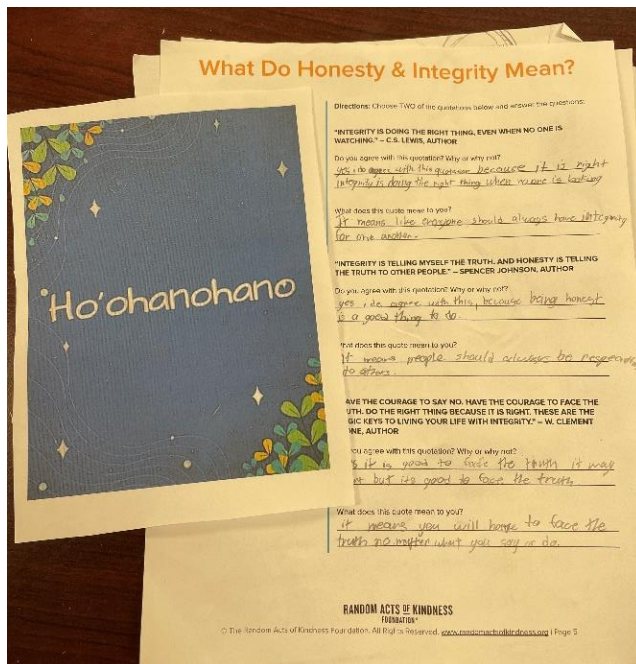
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STEM

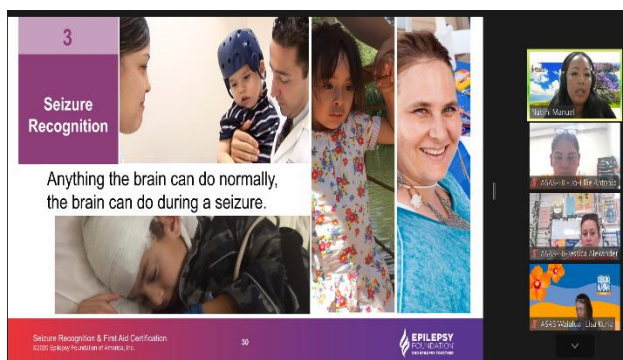
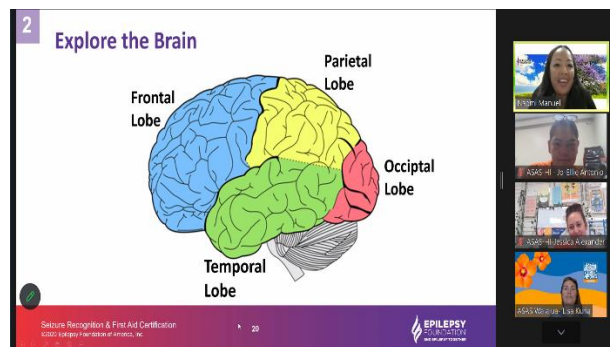
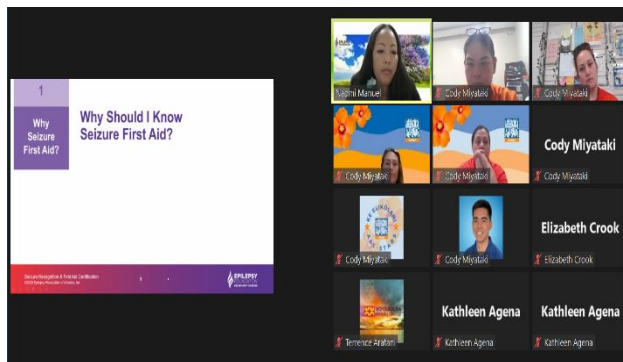
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STAFF TRAININGS
