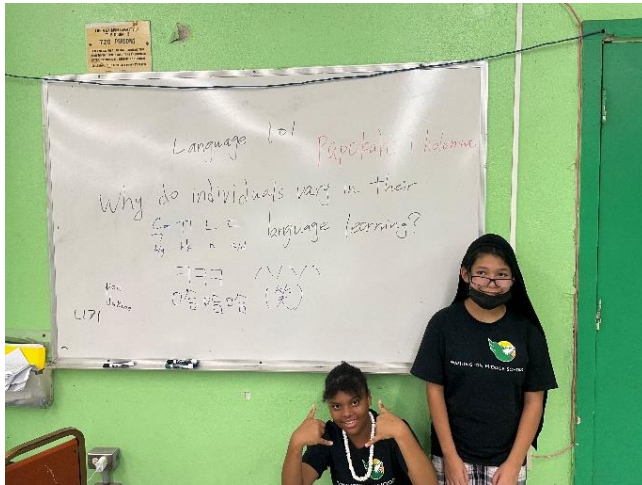
CLASSES

Photography class is going around campus either finding, or creating, photo opportunities.



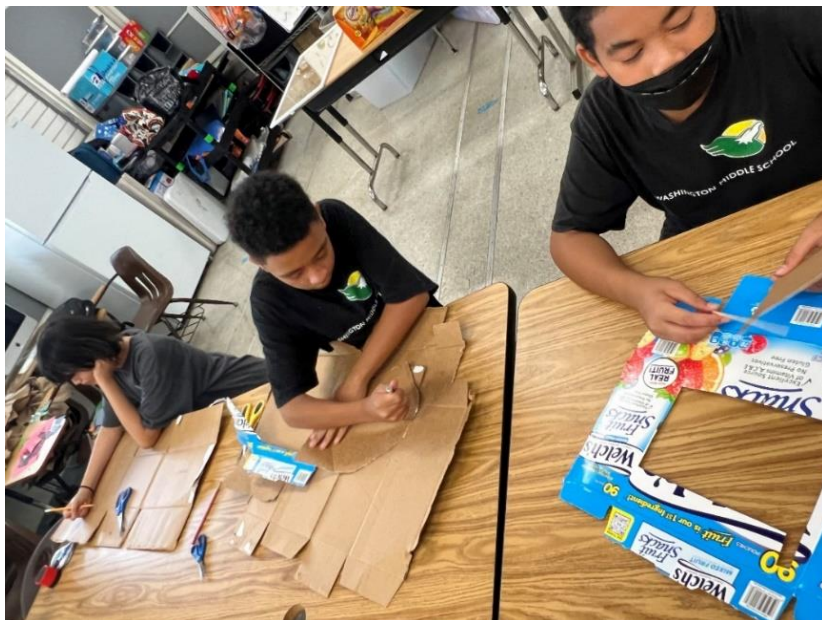
Cooking class has explored dishes from around the world and different cultures like these potato latkes to celebrate the beginning of Hanukkah.

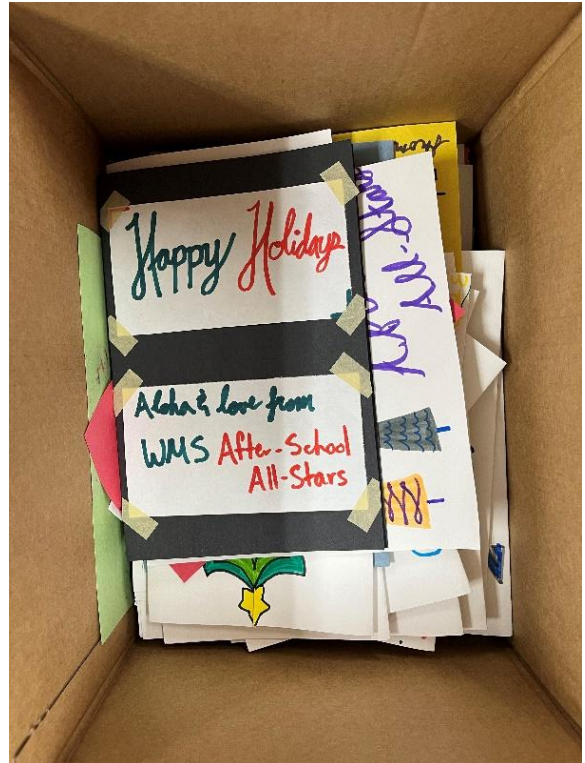
SERVICE LEARNING PROJECT – LIFE SERVICE ACTION

All-Stars students participated in a Spirit week for the holidays that had them wear holiday headwear to all red. Thank you to the students that participated each day!

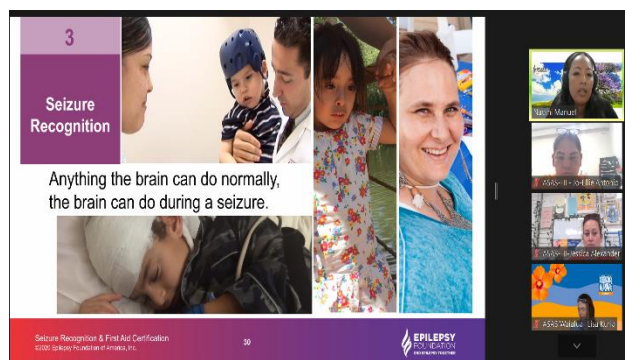
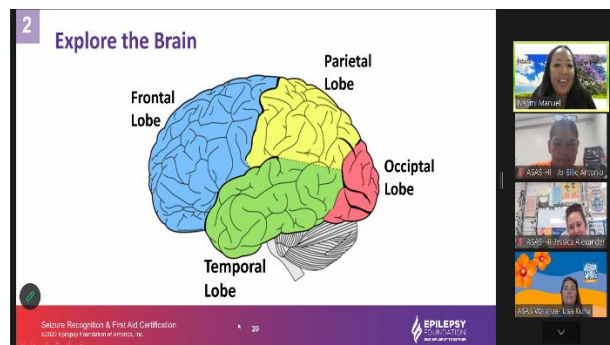
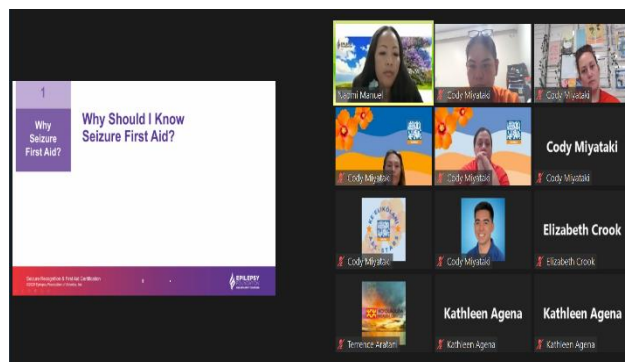
