In Archery, students who have been in the class for some time help the newer students. The class also worked on their aim and shooting skills.








In Hip-Hop class the students continue working on their choreography for Ho'ike.




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### CLASSES


Culture dance continue learning choreography to “Pualena” as they get ready for their performance at Ho’ike.





This month Jarrett All-Stars held a Family Bingo night. The families and students had so much fun.





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### SPECIAL EVENTS/CURRICULUM


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### YOUTH ADVISORY BOARD



The Yabbies this Month get ready to present their agendas for their Advisory Board meetings. by presenting a slide show to their fellow Yabbies from the other All-Star programs.




This Month, the All-Stars decided that they wanted to make thank you lollipop flowers for their parents to show how much they appreciate all the things they do for them.





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#### STEM
