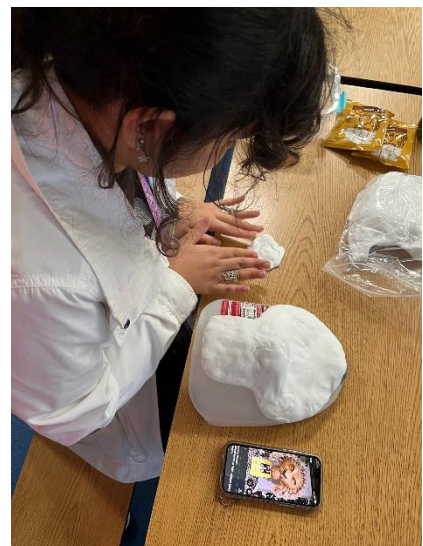
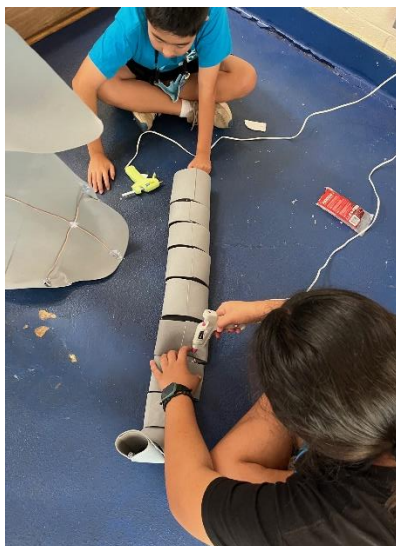
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### CLASSES

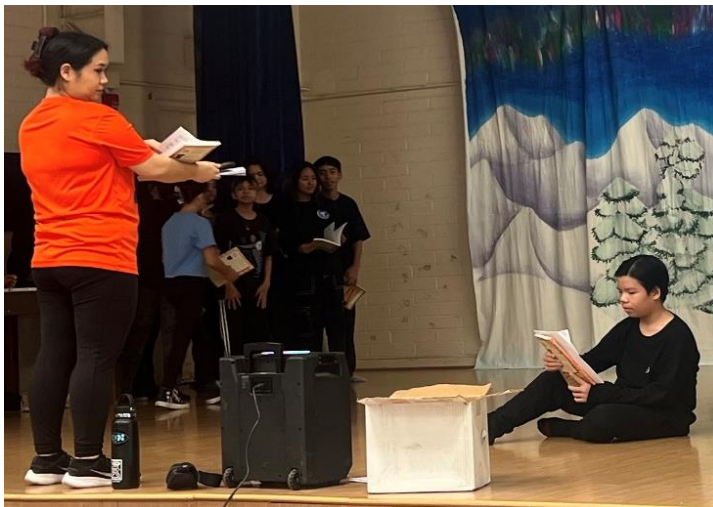




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### CLASSES

Mr. Tayler's Archery class has been focusing on the twelve steps of shooting. They are mainly focusing on creating a safe environment, while practicing the fundamentals.





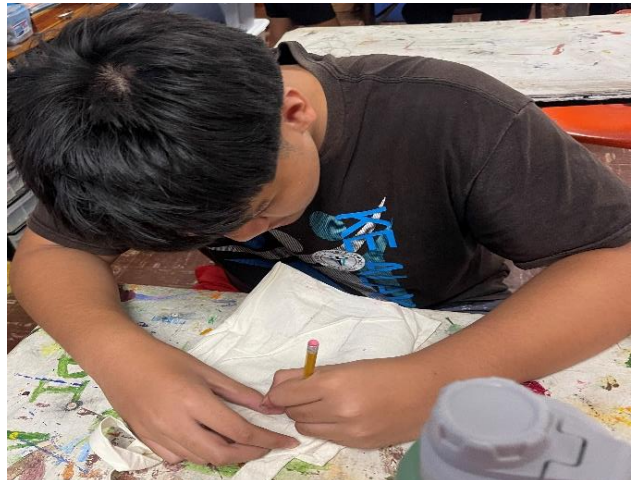
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### CLASSES

In our gamers class the students enjoy challenging each other in games of chess, Uno, mancala and even making different objects and structures out of Legos.



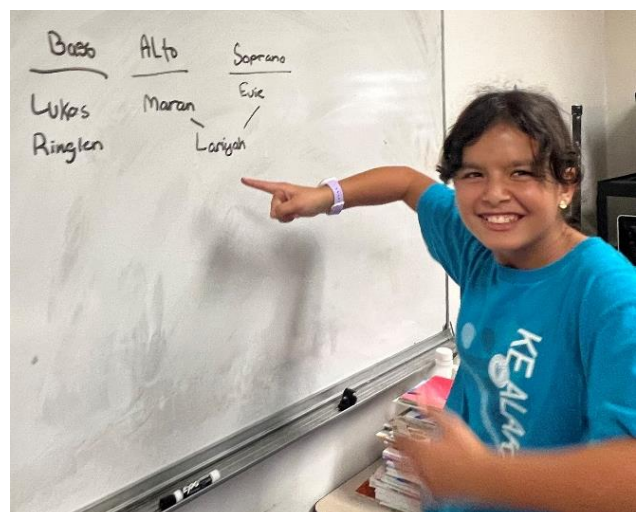
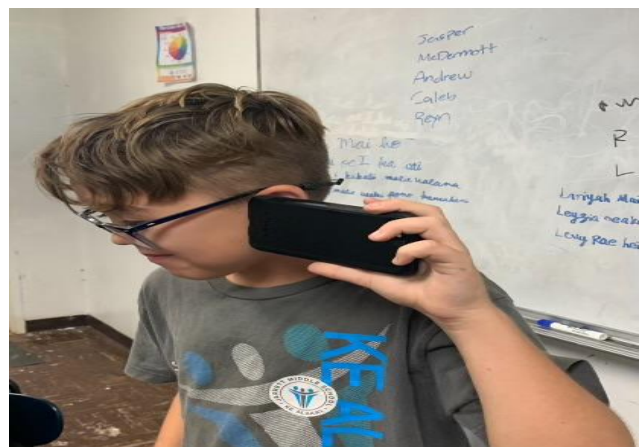
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### CLASSES



In Singing class, the students do vocal warm ups to exercise their throats so they don't strain them while singing and learning to recognize melodies.





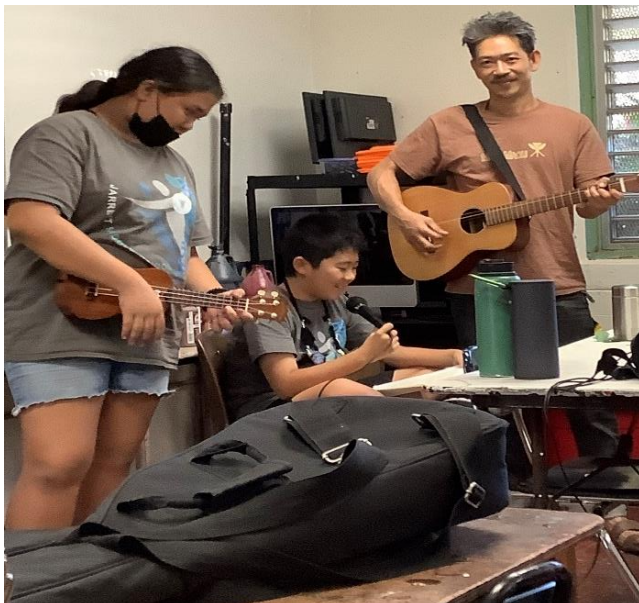
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#### CLASSES

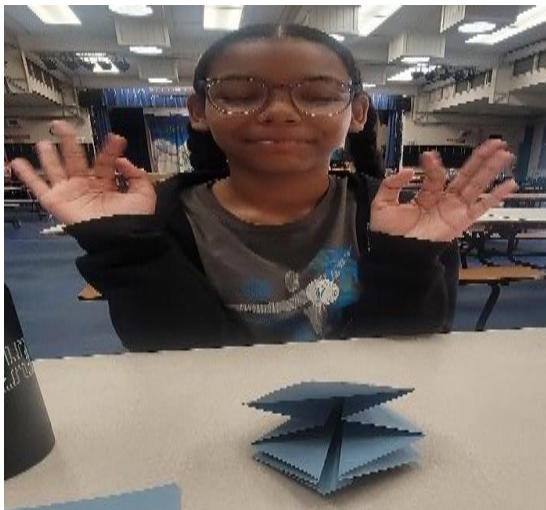
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### CLASSES

Some of their work includes origami hearts, cranes, boxes and more. After, students may keep or gift their art pieces to others.

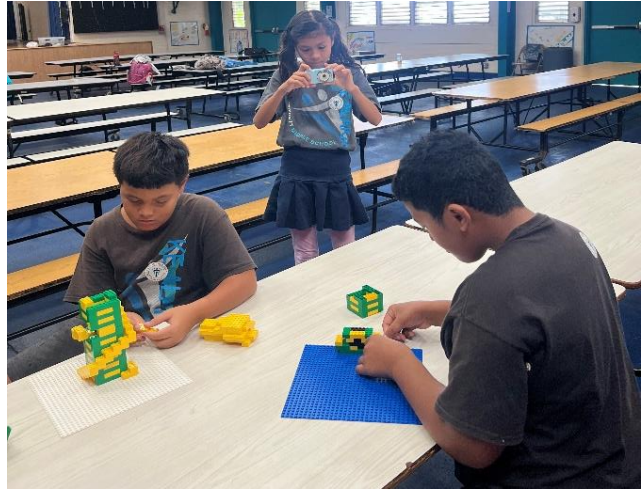

In Photography class the students are learning the basic functions of their cameras and learning to capture high quality images of people and places around them.







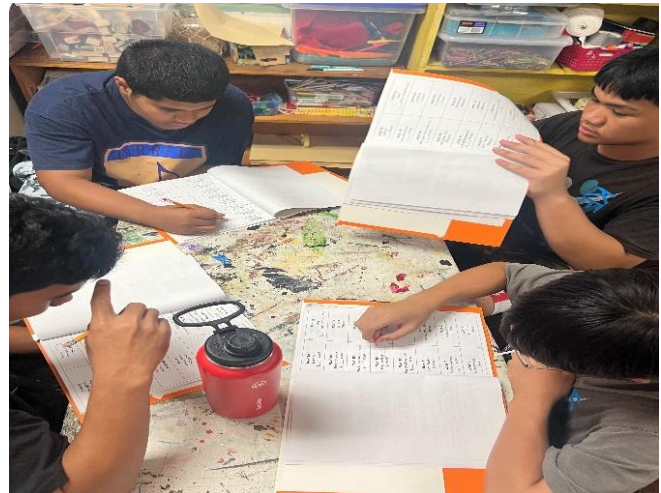
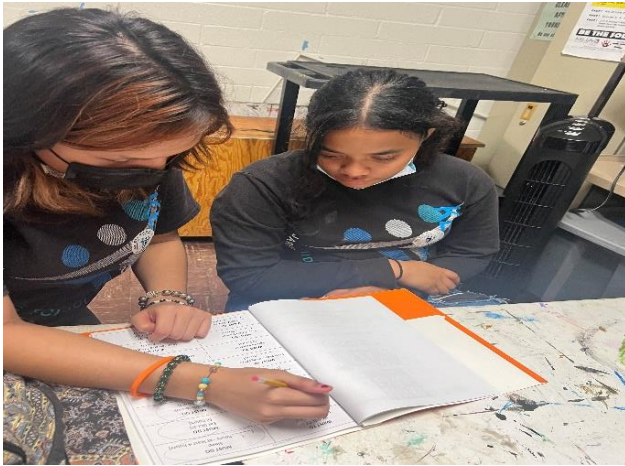
## 2023-24 Program Highlights

Our Youth Advisory Board students led their fellow All-Stars to make “Thank You Super Hero” candy bars for Jarrett staff to show their appreciation for what they do.





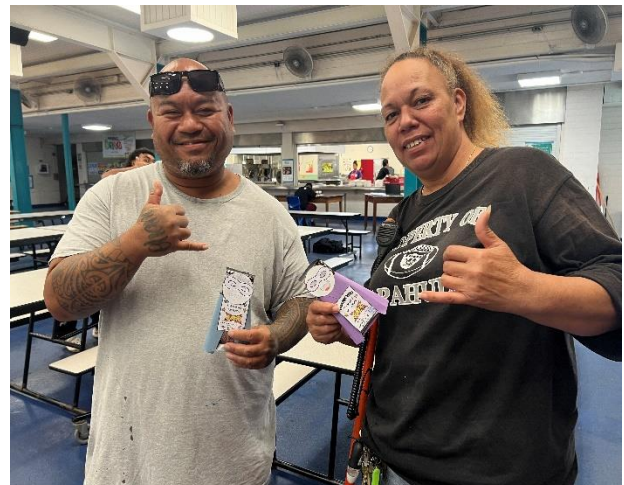
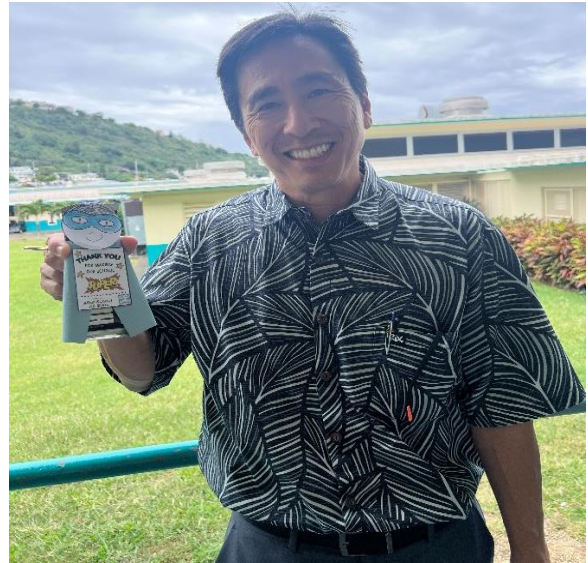


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### SERVICE LEARNING PROJECT – LIFE SERVICE ACTION

Jarrett School staff were so excited to receive the yummy Super Hero Thank You bars from our All-Star students.





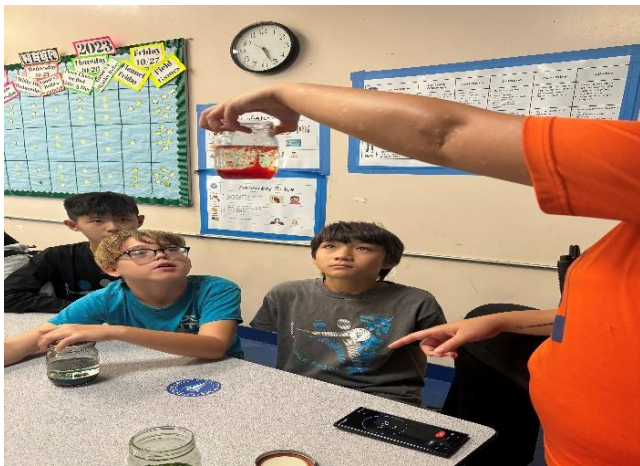
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### STEM

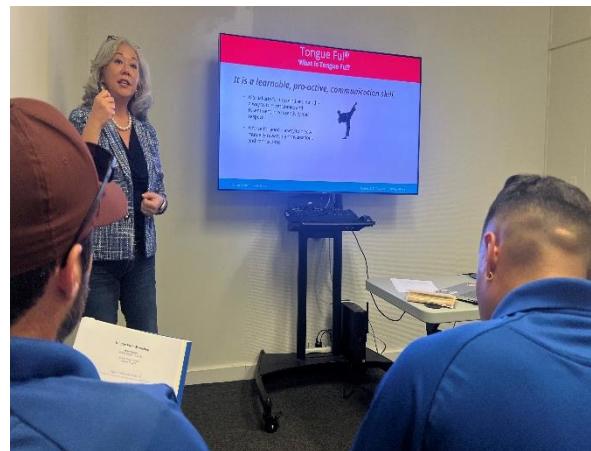
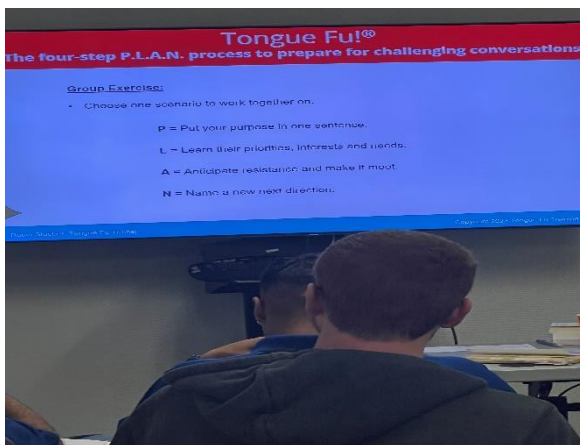
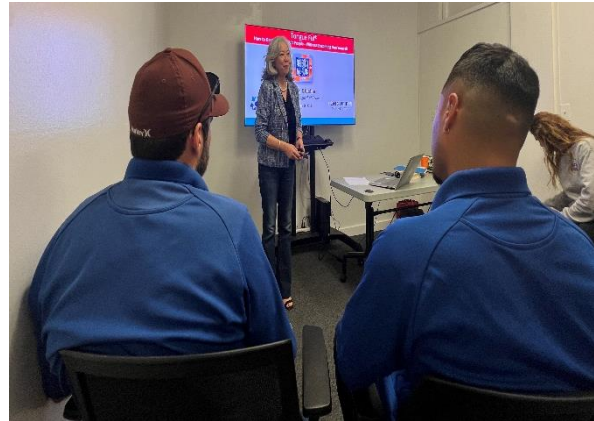


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### STAFF TRAININGS

All-Stars held a training in the art of Tongue-Fu by Mrs. Robin Stueber. Staff learned how to deal with difficult situations and also how to communicate better.



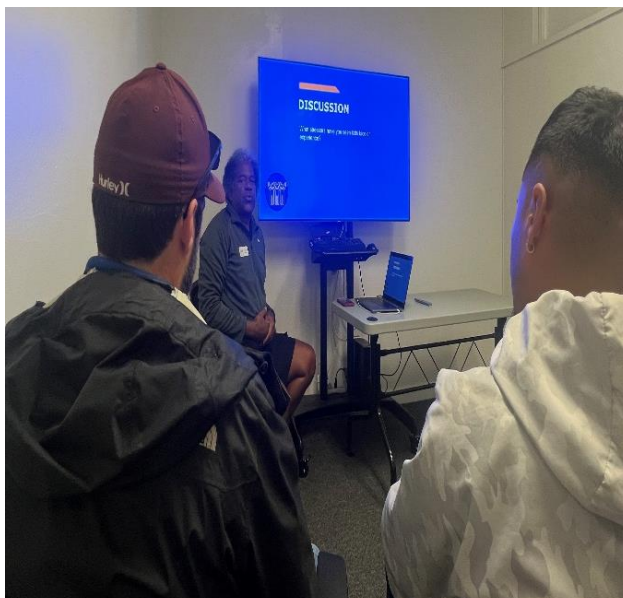
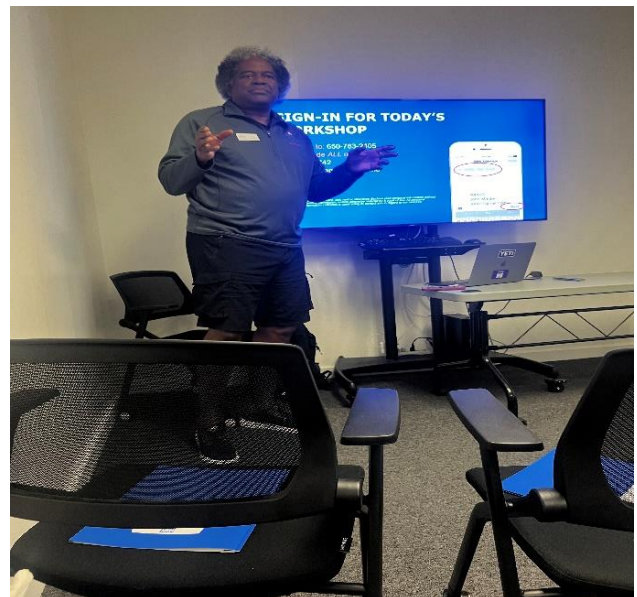
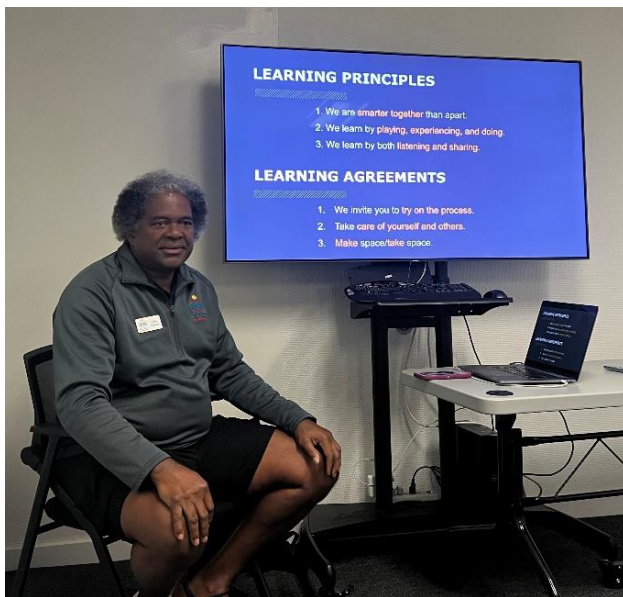


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### STAFF TRAININGS
