King All-Star's Cooking Class learn how to properly cook chicken for their delicious Chicken Bacon Ranch Melts.






















King All-Star's Painting Class get some fresh air and take their canvases outdoors where they used water color paint to portray the scenery around them.







King All-Star's Multi Sports Class bring back basketball and refresh their defense skills during a scrimmage.







