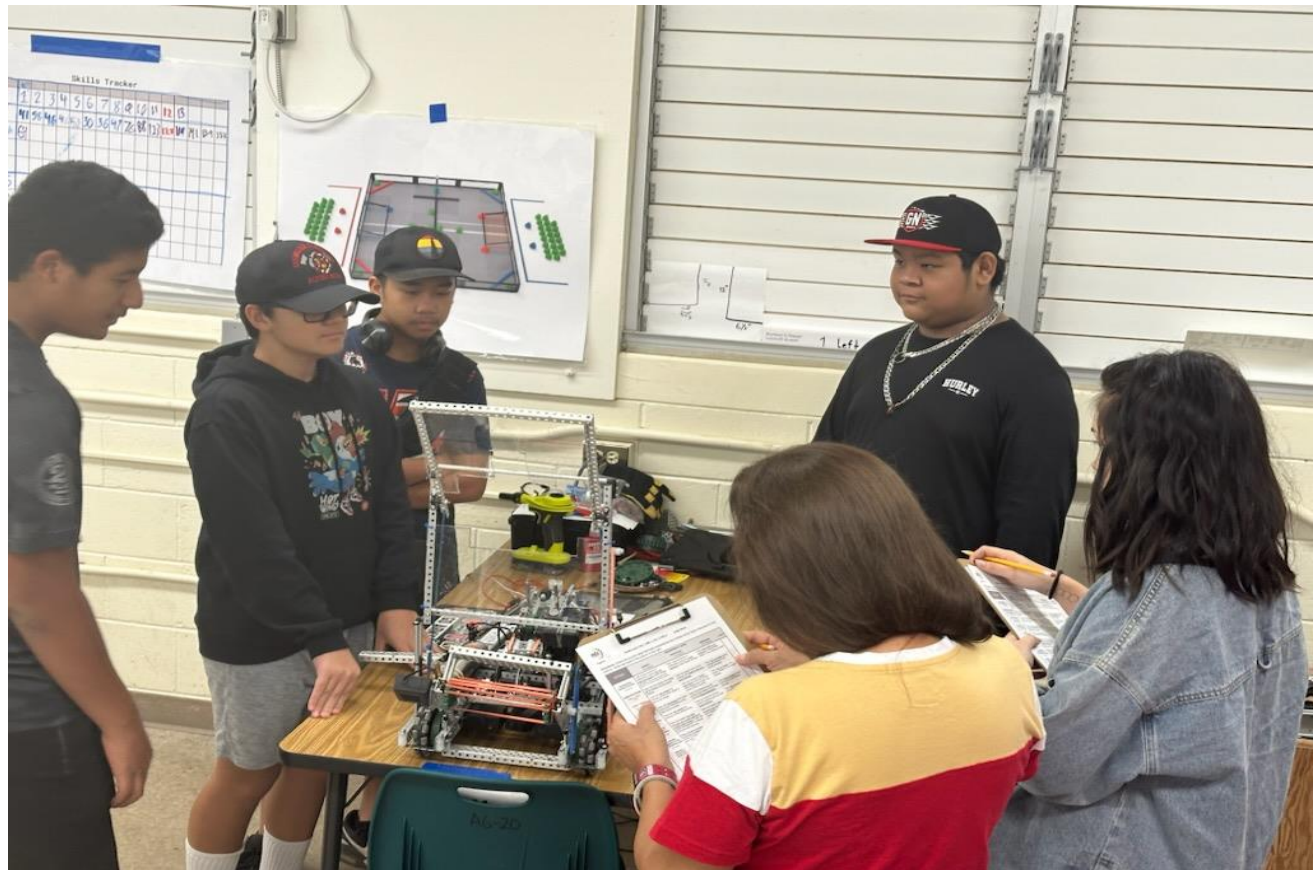


All-Stars Waianae wrestling team continue to build on strengthening take down techniques but not before putting in some core workouts.

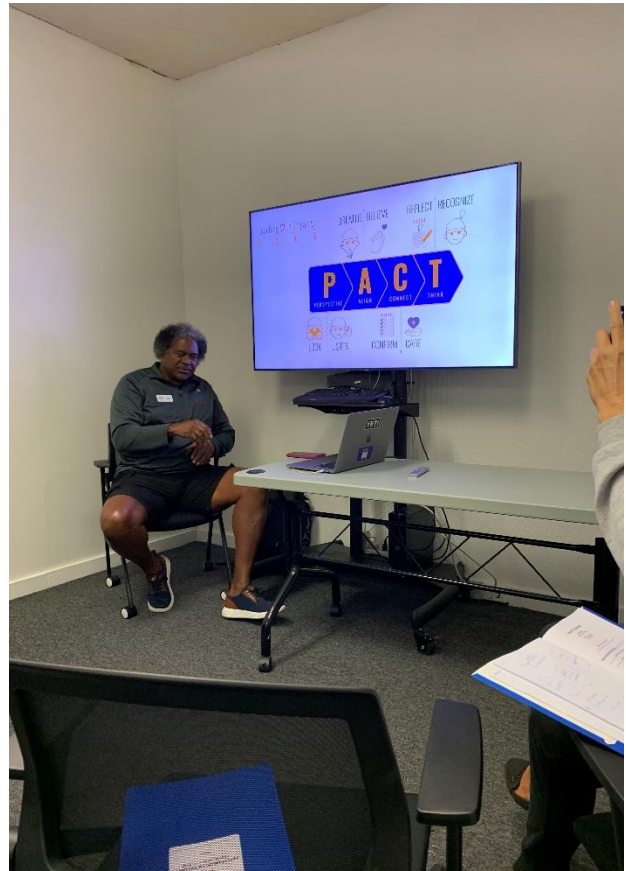

STAFF TRAININGS

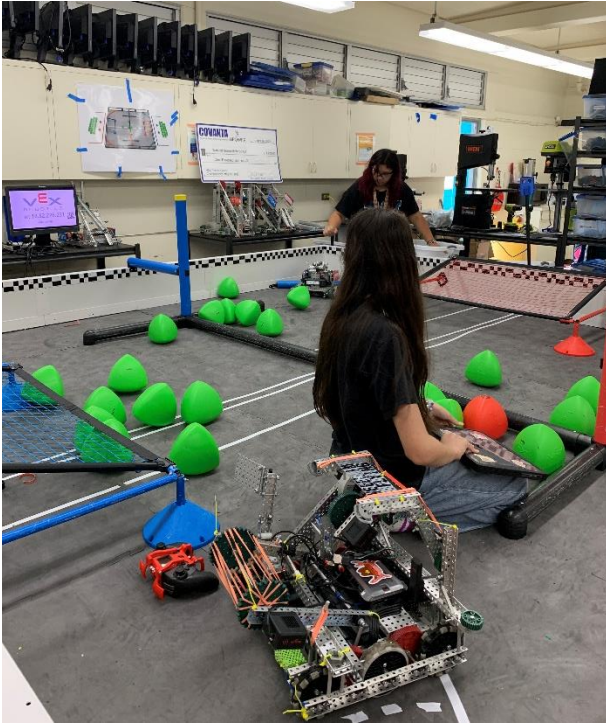


After-School All-Stars Hawaii Site Coordinators and Program team spent some quality time at some recent training.
