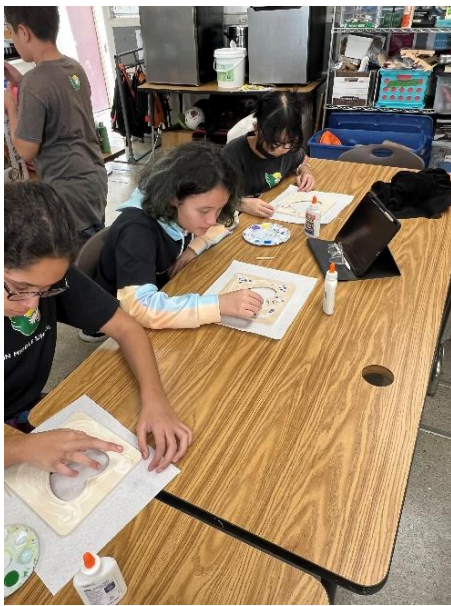

Great time for competition and for the students to showcase the hard work they have put in over the weeks.

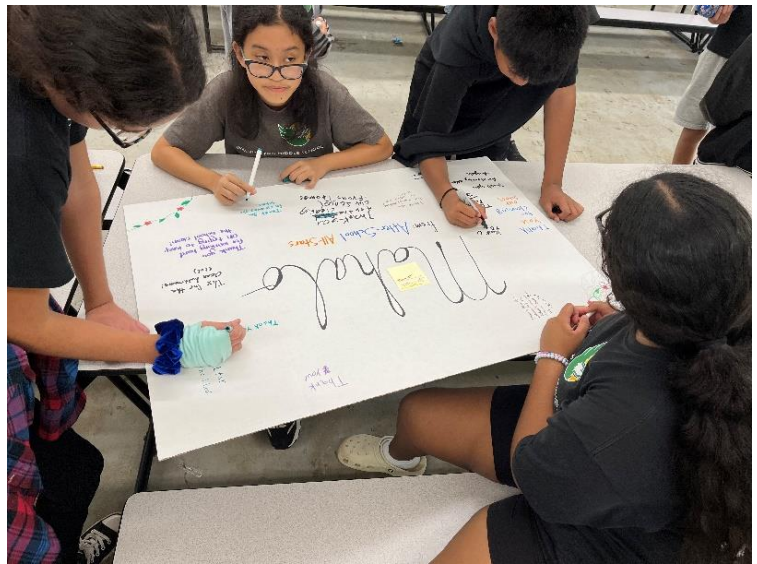
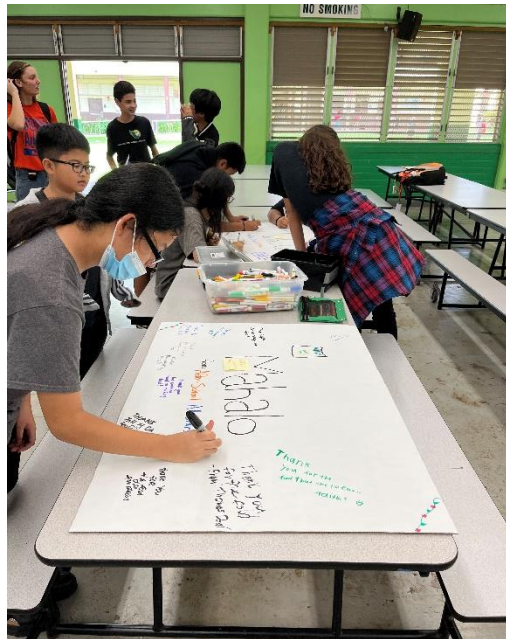

PLs and SCs from All-Stars programs on Oahu attended training at Washington Middle in preparation for the ASAL Flag Football season this quarter.

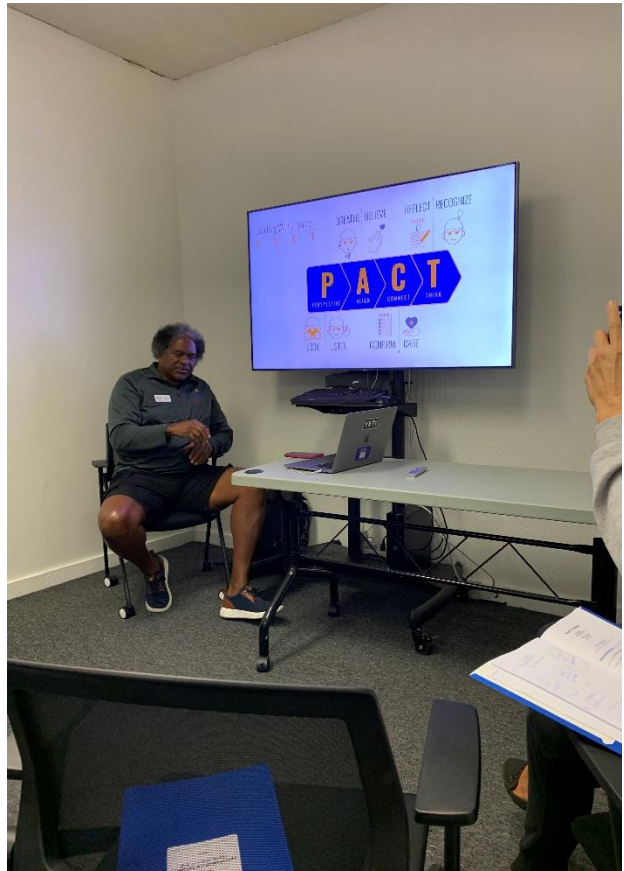

After-School All-Stars Hawaii Site Coordinators and Program team spent some quality time at some recent training.

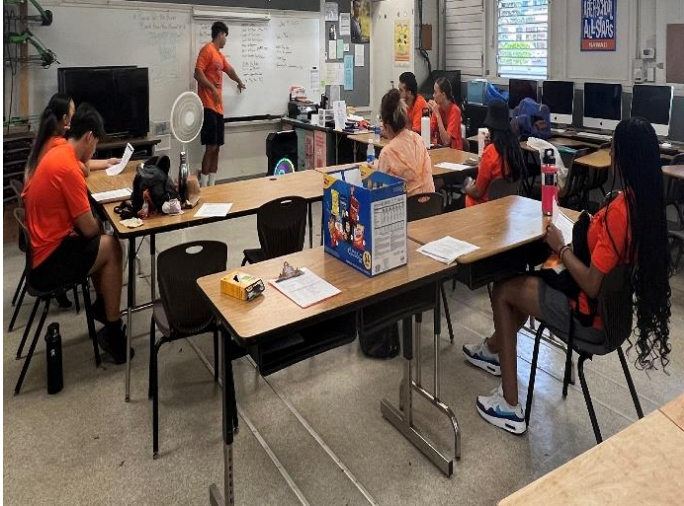
