

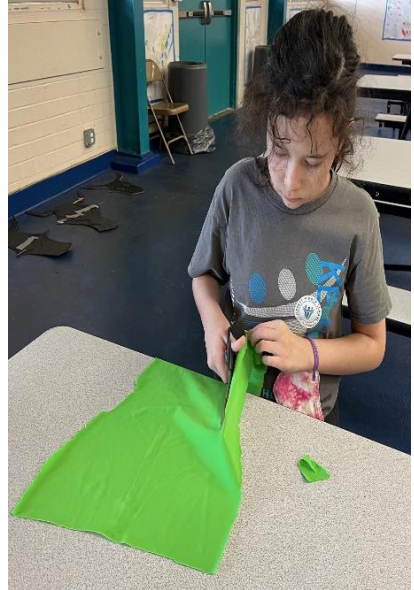

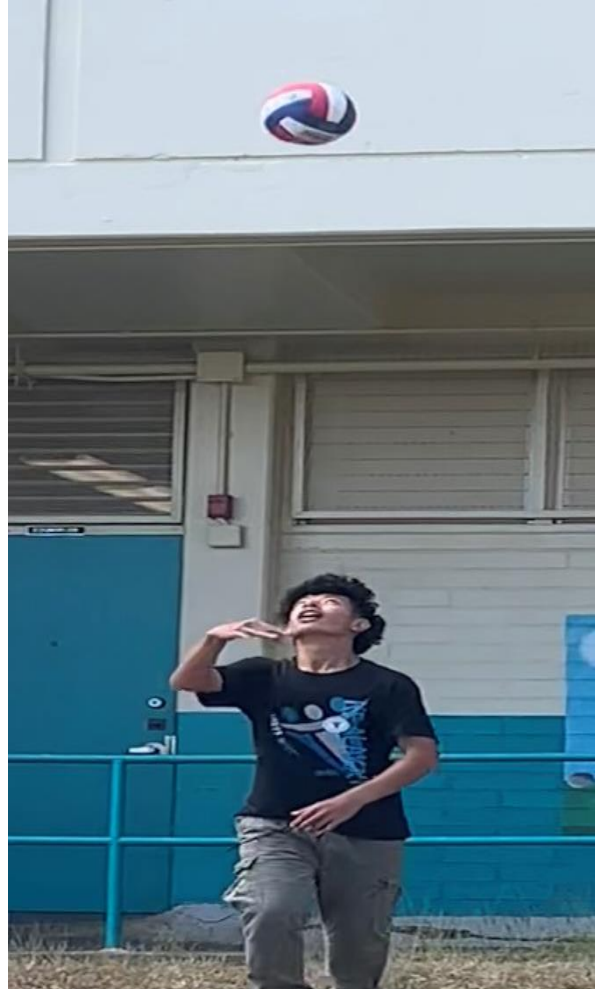
In Cultural Dance class, the students worked on different hula styles and practiced graceful hand motions.

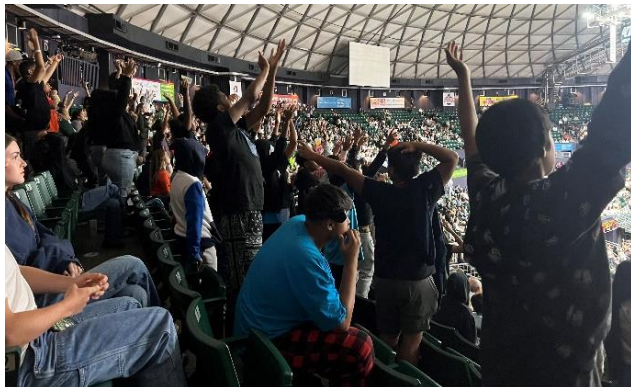

At Ho'ike, the All-Stars enjoyed performances from Mana Mele, cultural dance, hip-hop, musical and singing classes.



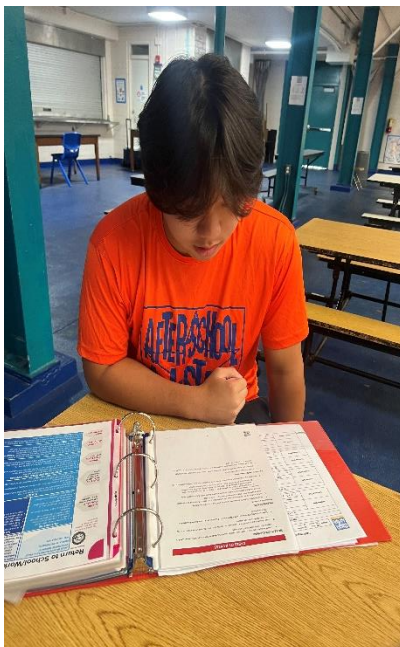
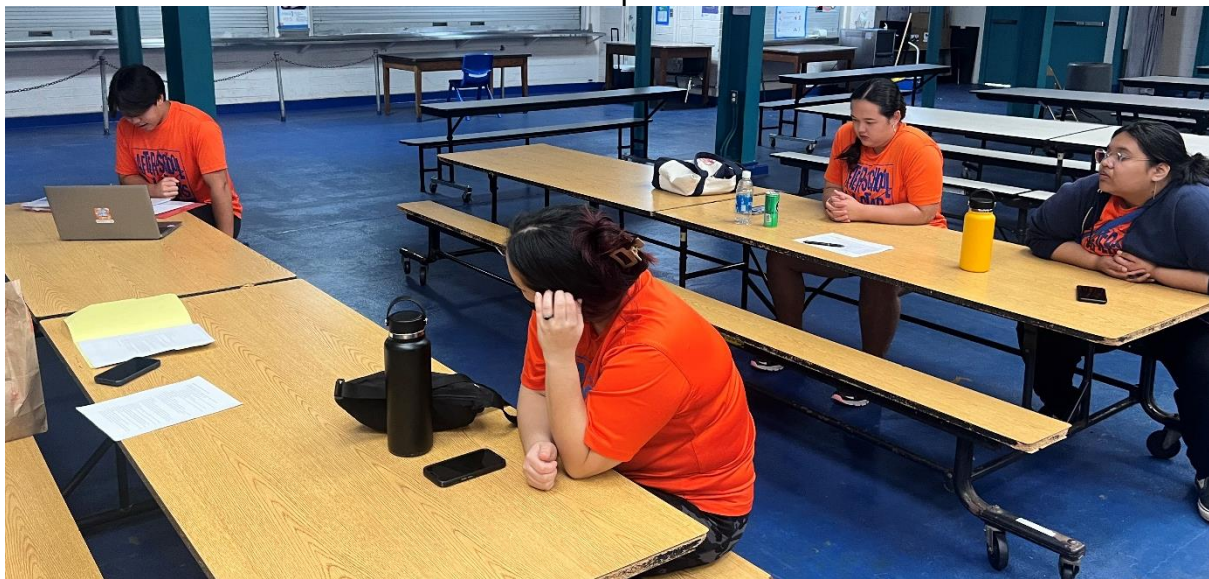
