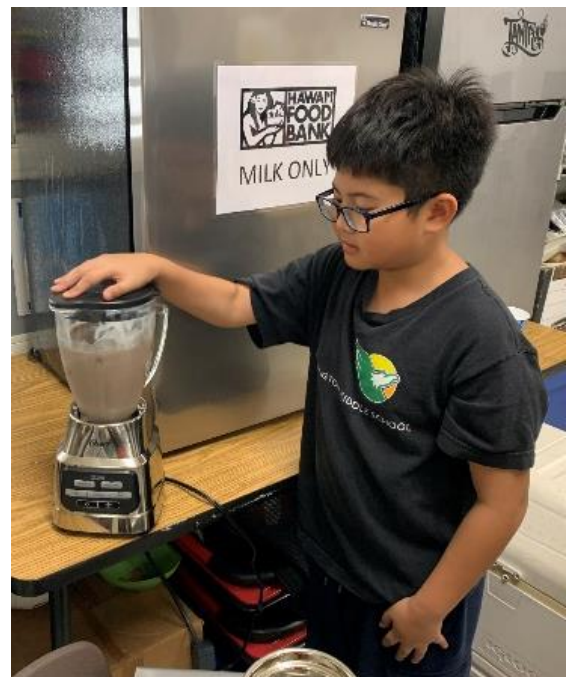

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Students in Baller Union compete in various games to keep their skills sharp.



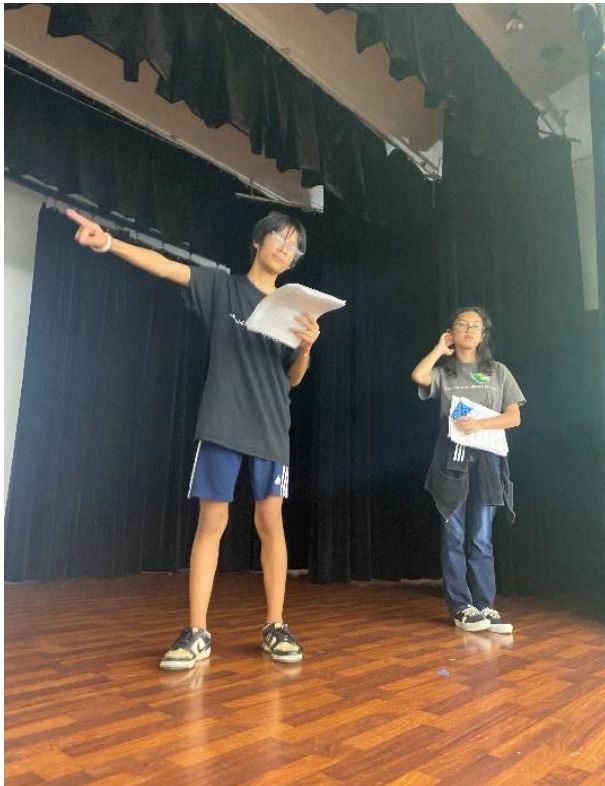
Football class is getting their reps, in preparation for competitions.

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### STEM

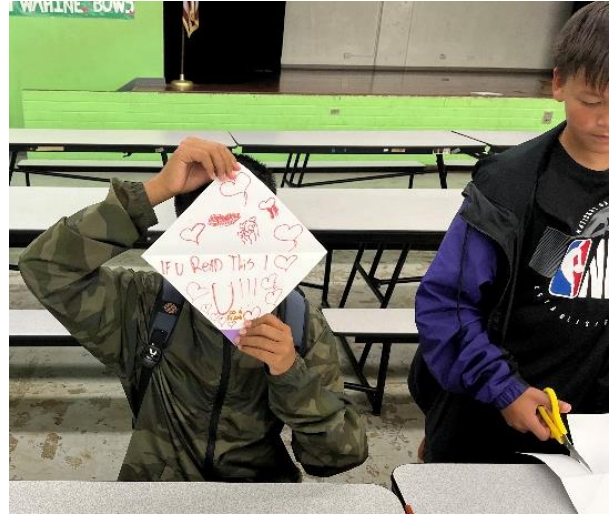


Students made their own custom shoes and slippers, as they learned about striving (Kulia) toward the future.
