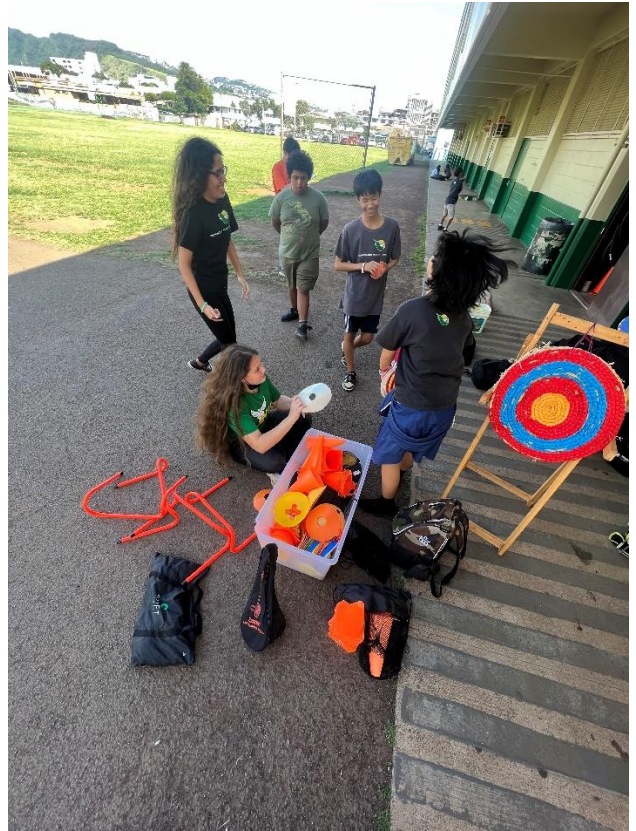

The Art classes came together to work on decorations and posters for Hoike. They created posters, put up balloons, and mini activities for the families to participate in throughout the night.

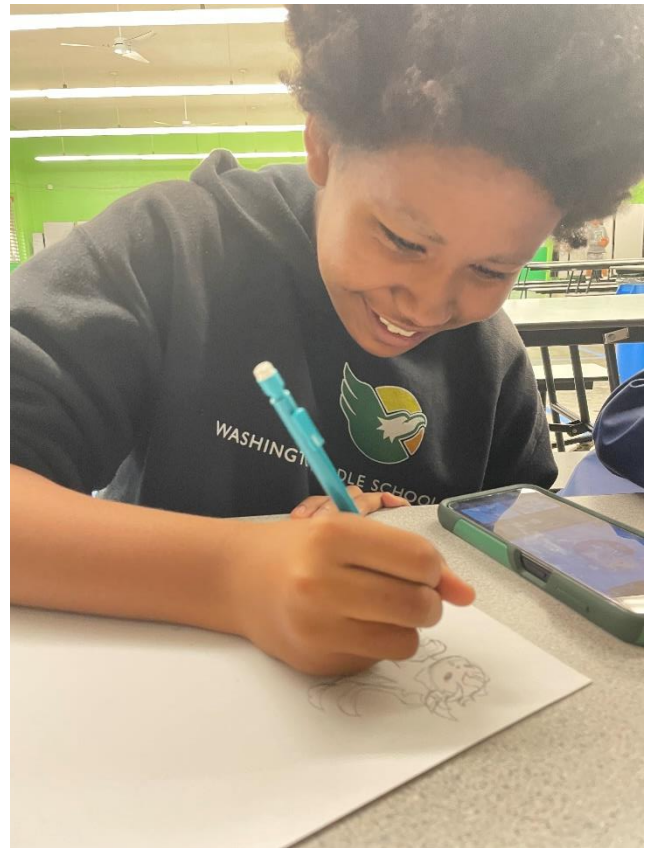
