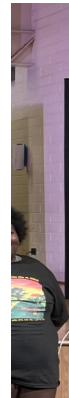

6th grade

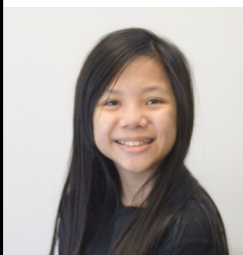
Favorite part: I love to learn different dance choreography. I love to be together with the actors, singers, dancers, & have fun together.

8th grade

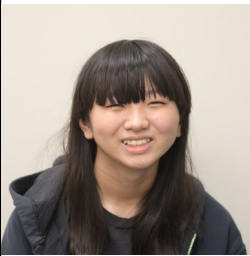
Favorite part: When rehearsing and you make a mistake, you can fix the mistake.

Favorite part: The songs, the people, and everything. Also, the events and helping with backdrop.

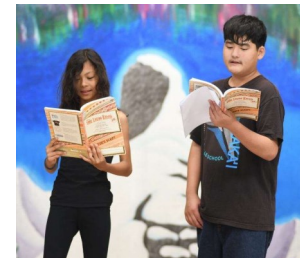
Most difficult part: On Saturdays, staying until 4pm or later. Figuring out what role you have.
