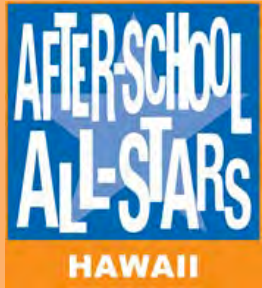

Students learn the fundamentals of archery and perfecting their shots. It takes patience, commitment, and perseverance to shoot a bullseye.



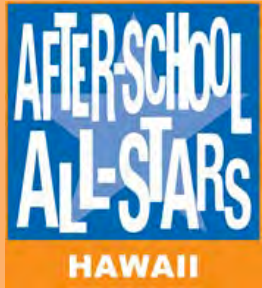

To help shy incoming 6th graders, their fellow 7th and 8th grade friends warm them up by teaching them a fun dance.



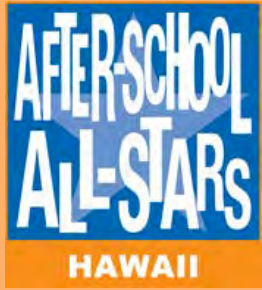

In Cooking class students learn to expand their palette and knowledge of various meals. They also learn kitchen safety and the importance of following instructions during class.

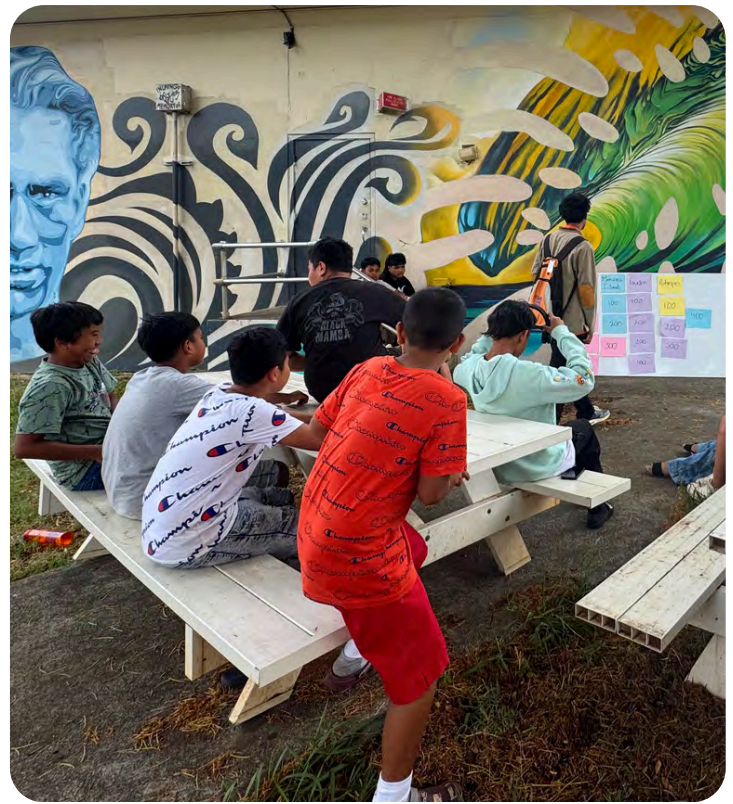


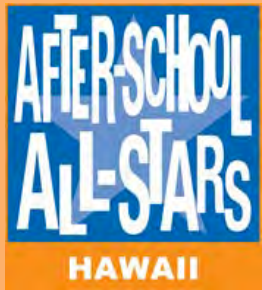

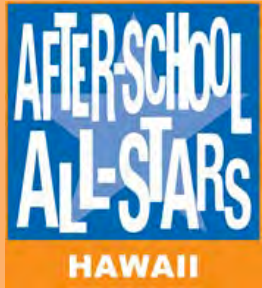

As summer continues, students enjoy games like freeze tag, flag tag, two truths and one lie, and more. Students work together and develop friendships as they learn new things about each other.



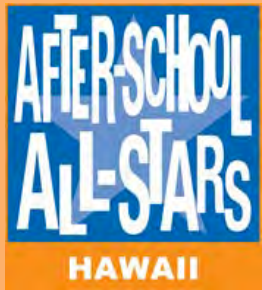
