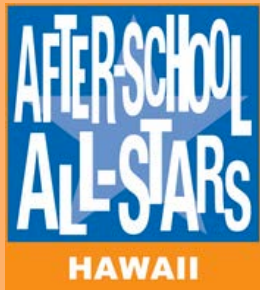


KALAKAUA MIDDLE AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS JULY 2025

Site Coordinators participated in training focused on positive motivation, addressing challenging behaviors, effective classroom management, and time management strategies.



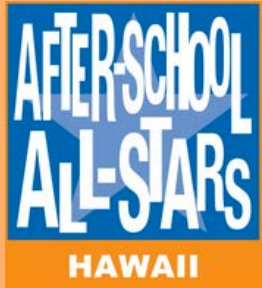

Kalakaua All-Stars staff prepared for the new school year by developing courses, creating lesson plans, and organizing classroom supplies for students.

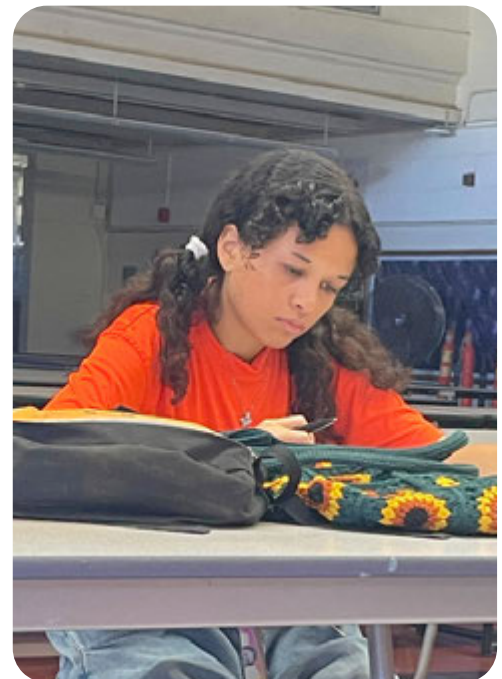
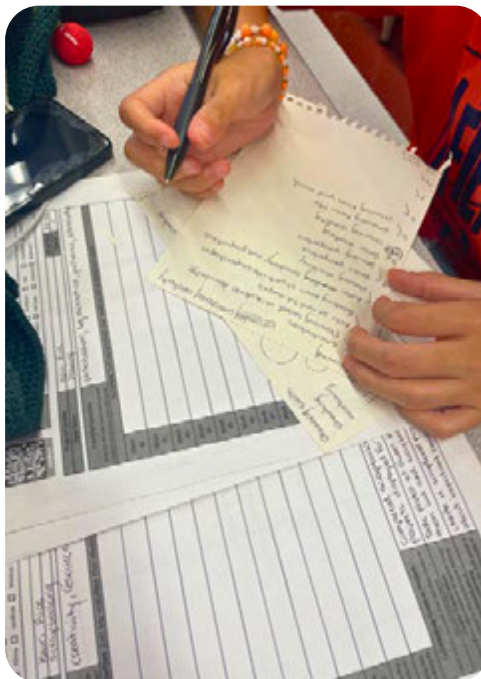


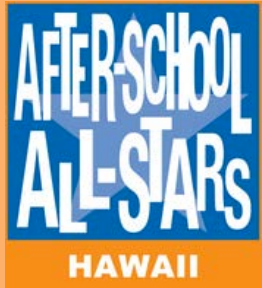

Staff focused on creating safe, supportive environments where students can enjoy learning, build skills, and succeed in school and beyond.

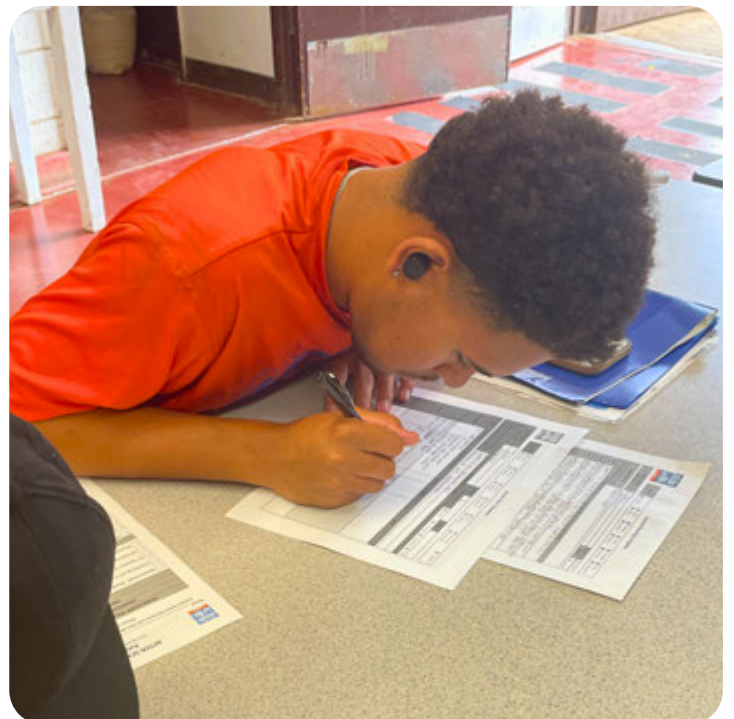


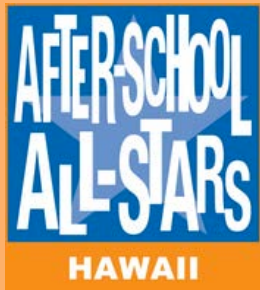
