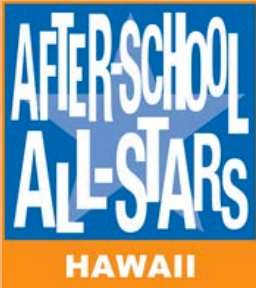


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SPORTS SHOWDOWN

The Sports Showdown helped students discover a new sport and new friendships, celebrating with awards and prizes.





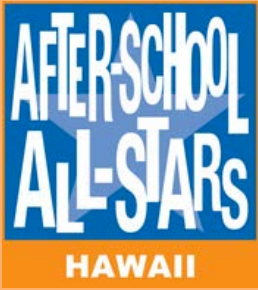
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HAWAIIAN VALUES

Through professional development, Waiakea staff members strive for excellence, building trust in one another and learning classroom management skills to ensure a successful first quarter of the new school year.





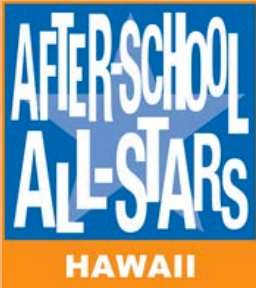
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STAFF RETREAT



After-School All-Stars Site Coordinators have fun learning at the annual Staff Retreat. It was a day of team building activities, guest speakers, and awards.





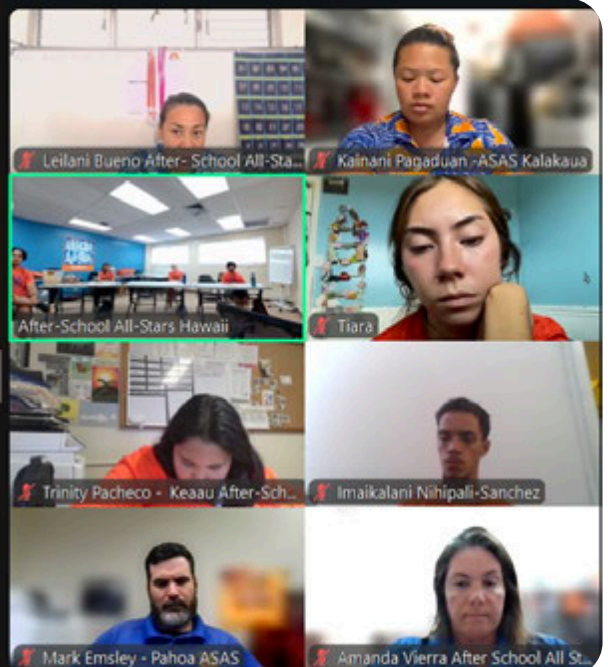
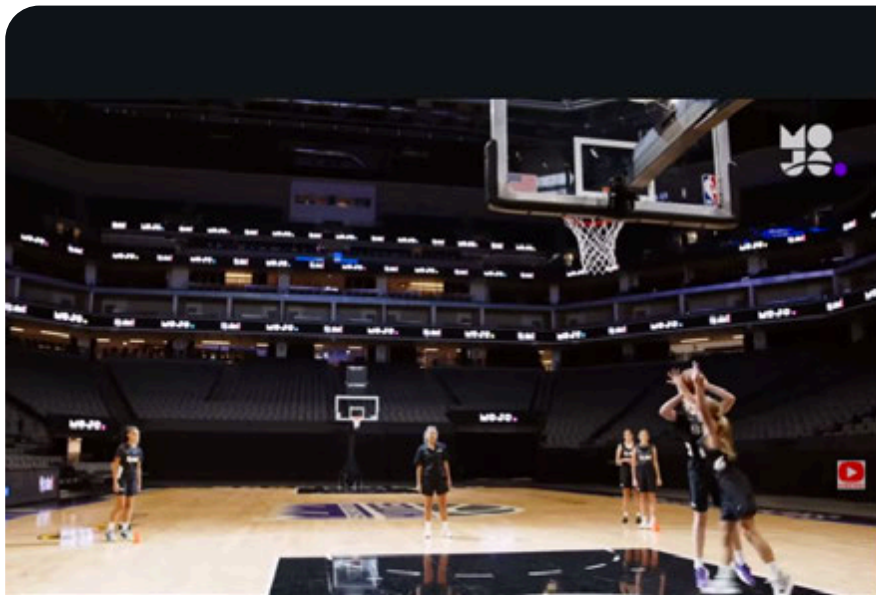
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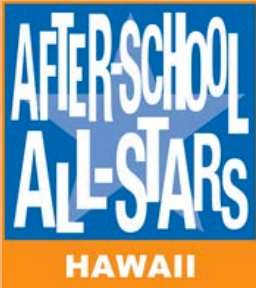
BASKETBALL CLINIC
