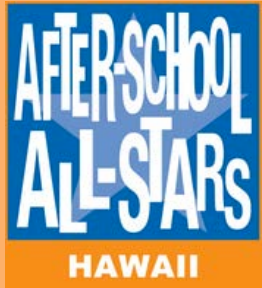


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UKULELE

Ukulele students continue to enjoy making music in a fun and supportive environment. Students are getting comfortable with basic chords, and their focus has been on strumming techniques.



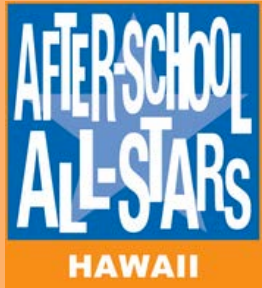


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VOLLEYBALL

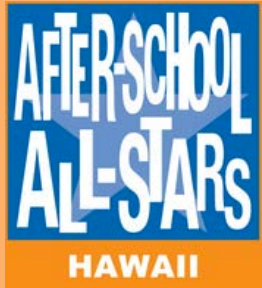


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ALL-STARS ATHLETIC LEAGUE (ASAL) BASKETBALL GAMES

Our ASAL basketball games brought players, coaches, and families together. Rather than focusing solely on competition, these events highlight teamwork, sportsmanship and growth.



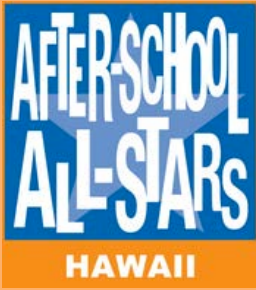


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ASAL BASKETBALL GAMES

All-Stars from across O'ahu enjoyed the ASAL basketball games and meeting other students from the different programs.





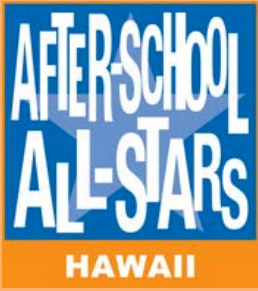
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LIFE SERVICE ACTION
