

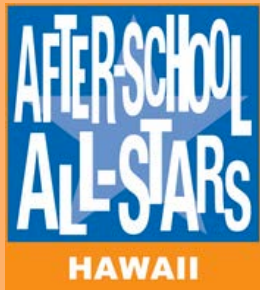

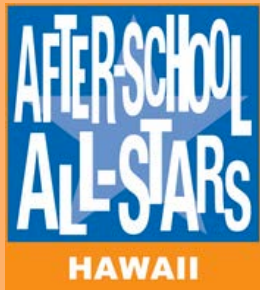

All-Stars enjoy being active and learn two-touch football, mastering quick passes, sharp footwork, and teamwork along the way.



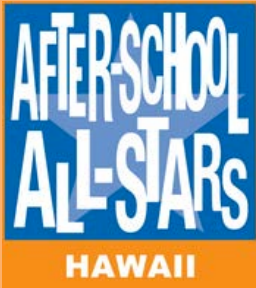


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BASKETBALL

Our ASAS Hawaii Health and Fitness Coordinator coached students on how to perform layups and shoot three-pointers.





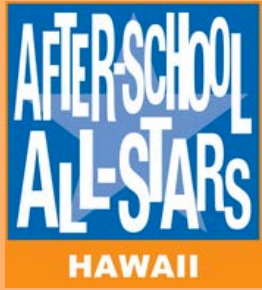
