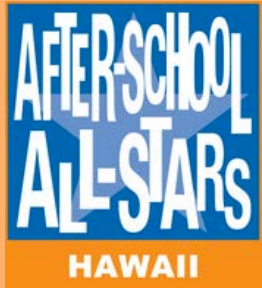

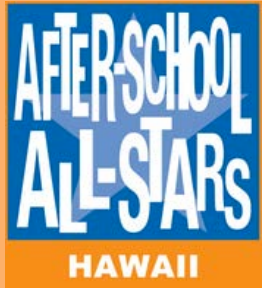


PAHOA INTERMEDIATE AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS SEPTEMBER 2025

Painting students explored creative expression through landscape art. They learned about foreground positioning and practiced using both acrylic and watercolor paints to bring their ideas to life.



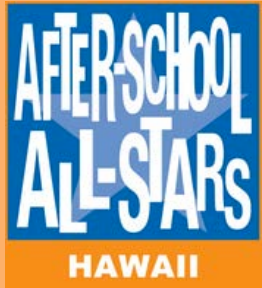

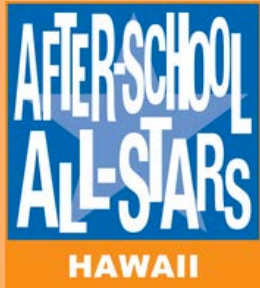
