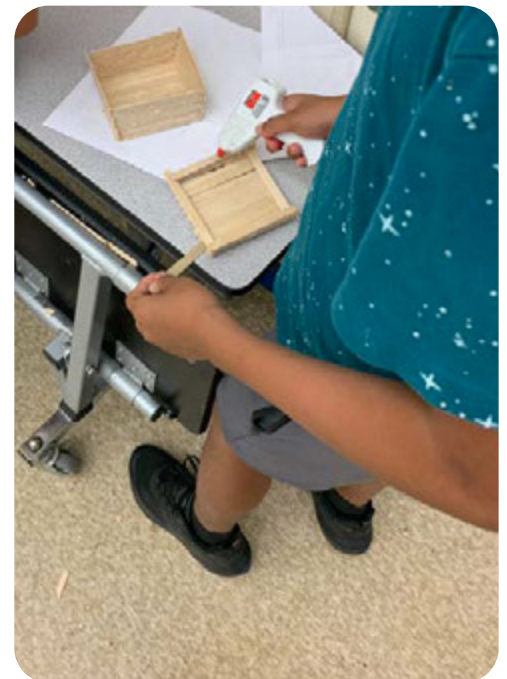
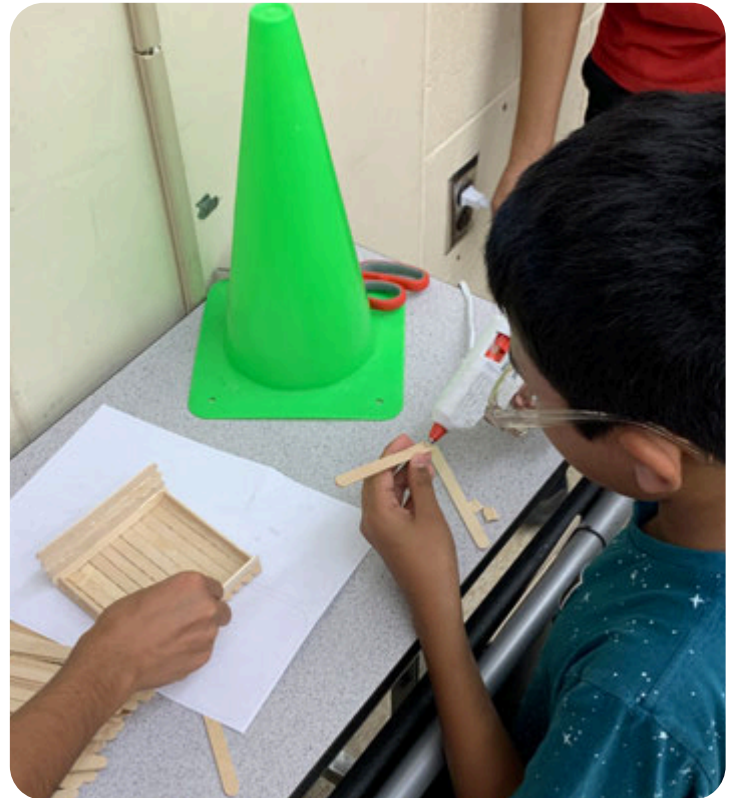


WAIKOLOA AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS JANUARY 2026

All-Stars practice shooting form and blocking techniques to strengthen their overall game. Through consistent effort, they build discipline, confidence, and perseverance on and off the court.





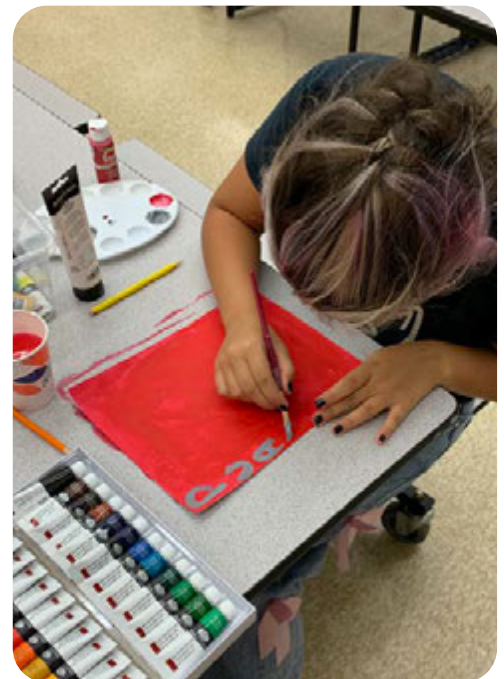

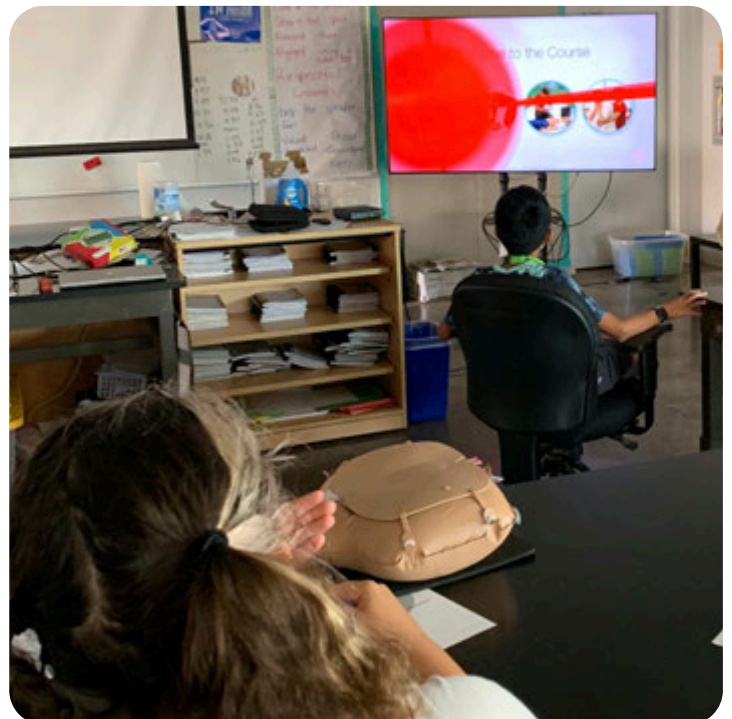
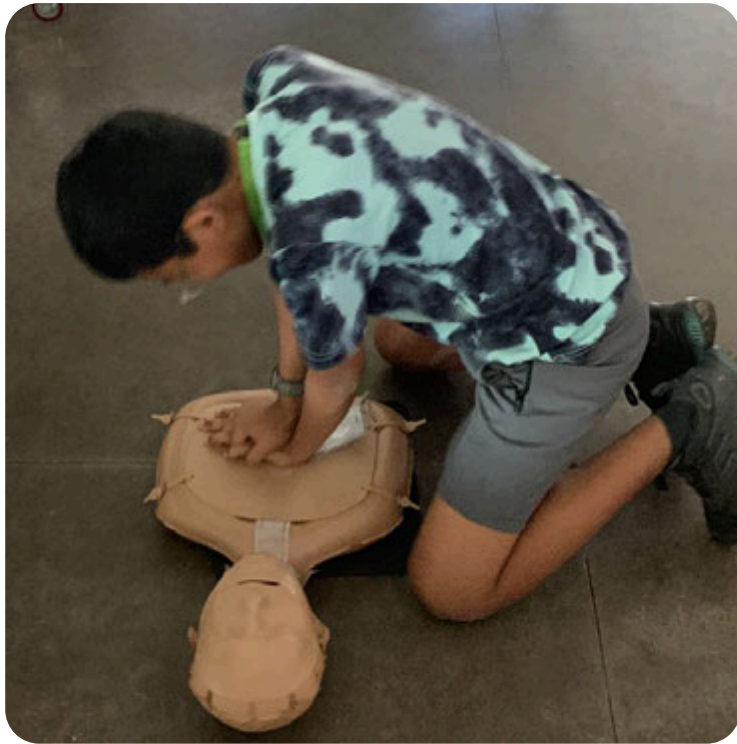




WAIKOLOA AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS JANUARY 2026

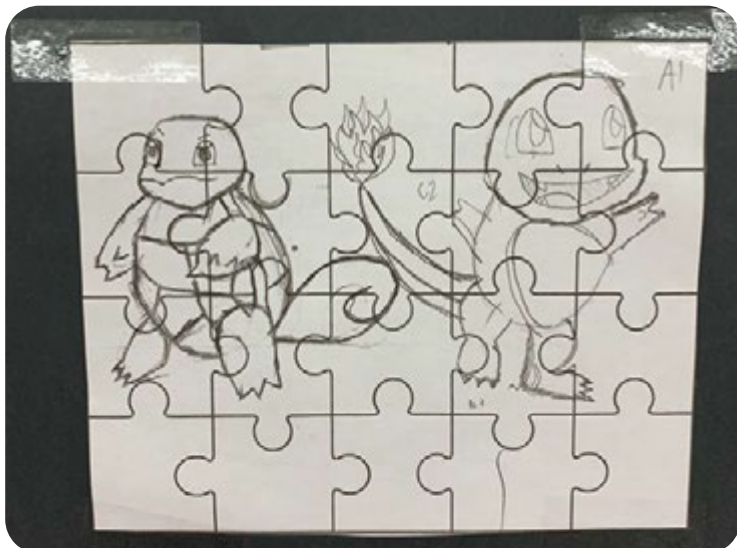




WAIKOLOA AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS JANUARY 2026
