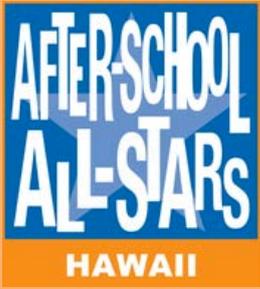


KALAKAUA MIDDLE AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS FEBRUARY 2026

FLAG FOOTBALL

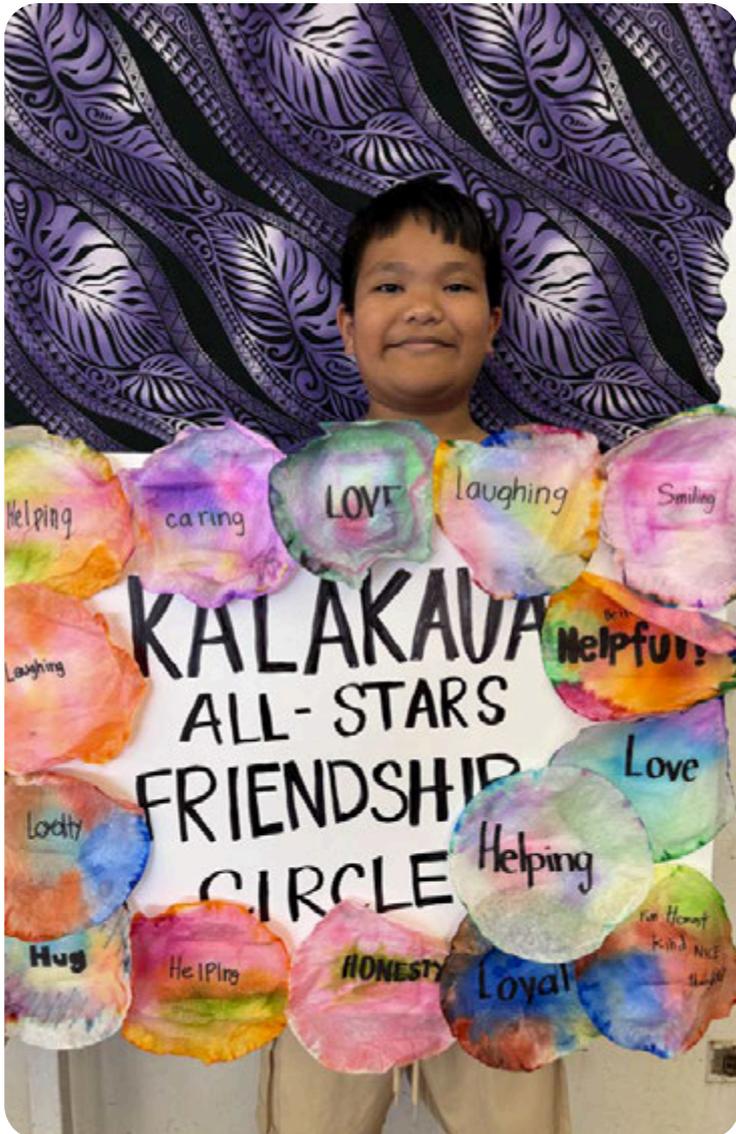

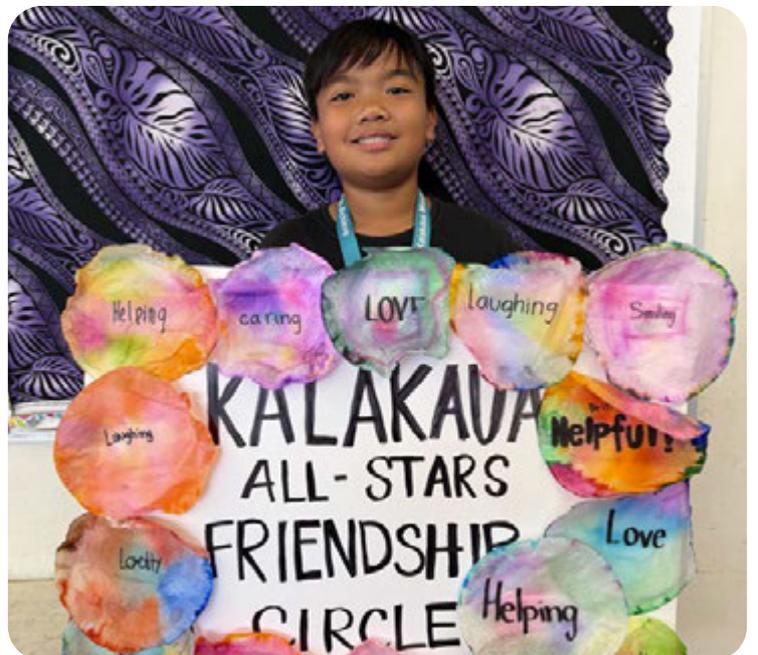

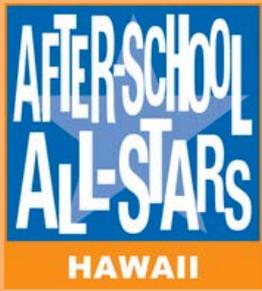
HAWAIIAN VALUE OF THE WEEK

Through small-group conversations, they share how these values are present in their daily lives and how they can strengthen their friendships.



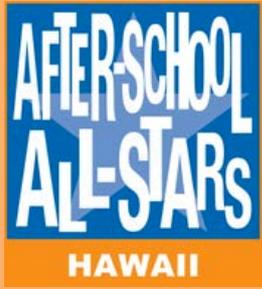

To celebrate the work of school counselors, All-Stars create and deliver special chip bags filled with handwritten notes to show their appreciation.



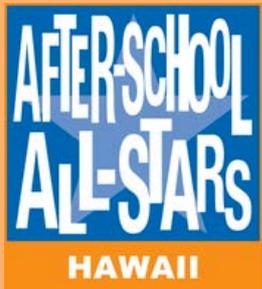


KALAKAUA MIDDLE AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS FEBRUARY 2026

All-Stars learn Hands-only CPR and AED training so they can respond confidently in an emergency. Students learn to recognize cardiac arrest, perform effective chest compressions, and use an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) through guided, hands-on practice.
