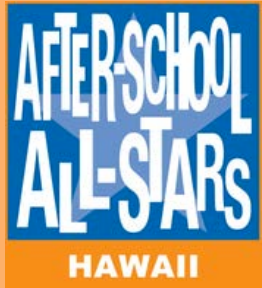


KALAKAUA MIDDLE SCHOOL AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS MARCH 2026

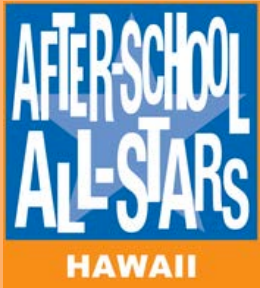


KALAKAUA MIDDLE SCHOOL AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS MARCH 2026

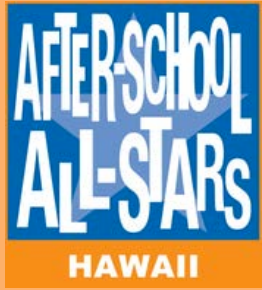

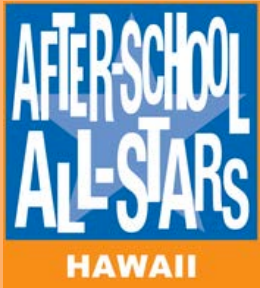

Students learn how to prepare simple, flavorful dishes they can recreate at home. Through guided instruction, they build confidence in the kitchen while developing independence and everyday life skills.

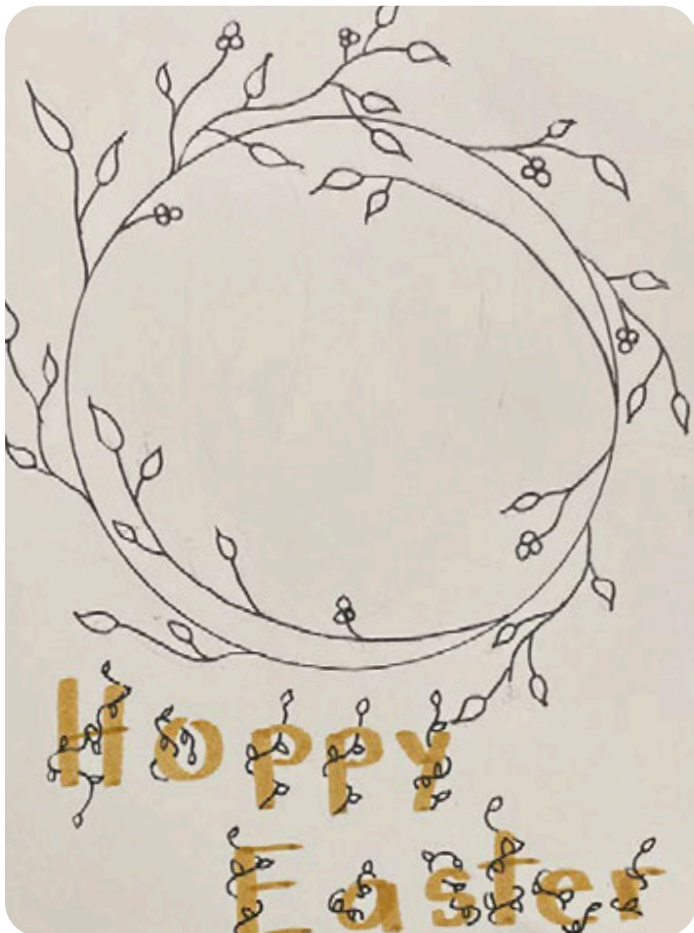


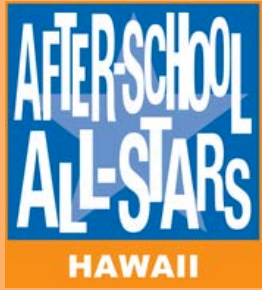

Students design and create spring themed cards for kupuna, using art as a way to give back to the community. The activity encourages empathy, creativity, and an understanding of the importance of honoring elders.



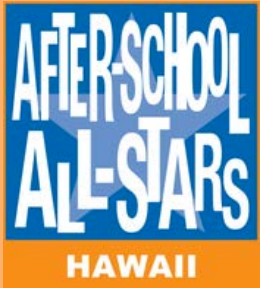


KALAKAUA MIDDLE SCHOOL AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS MARCH 2026

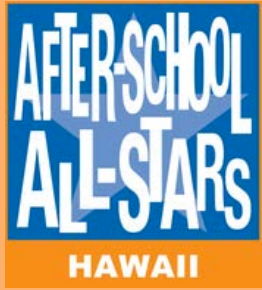

Students build skills in movement, coordination, and teamwork through structured flag football activities. They practice game strategies while learning the importance of communication and sportsmanship.

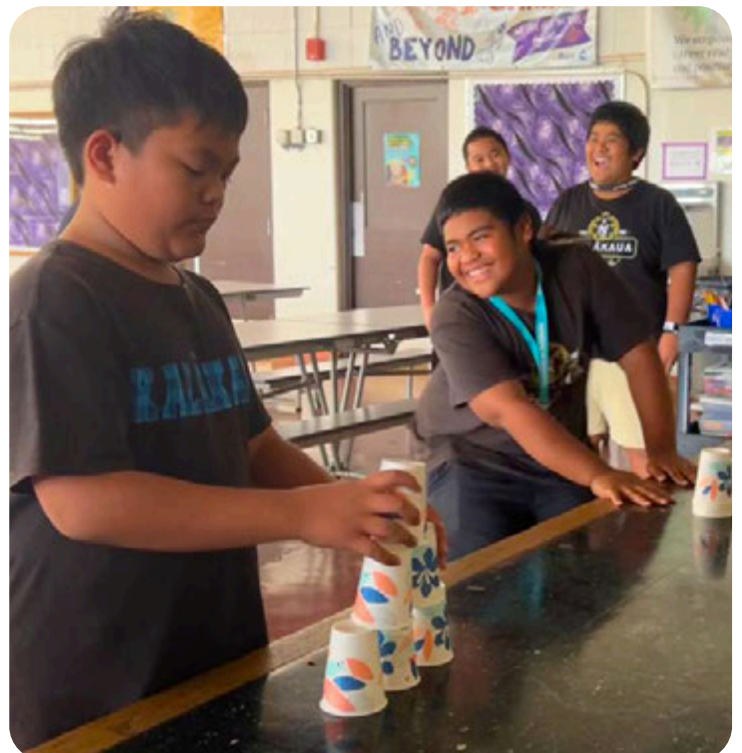


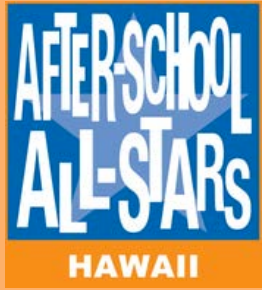


KALAKAUA MIDDLE SCHOOL AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS MARCH 2026

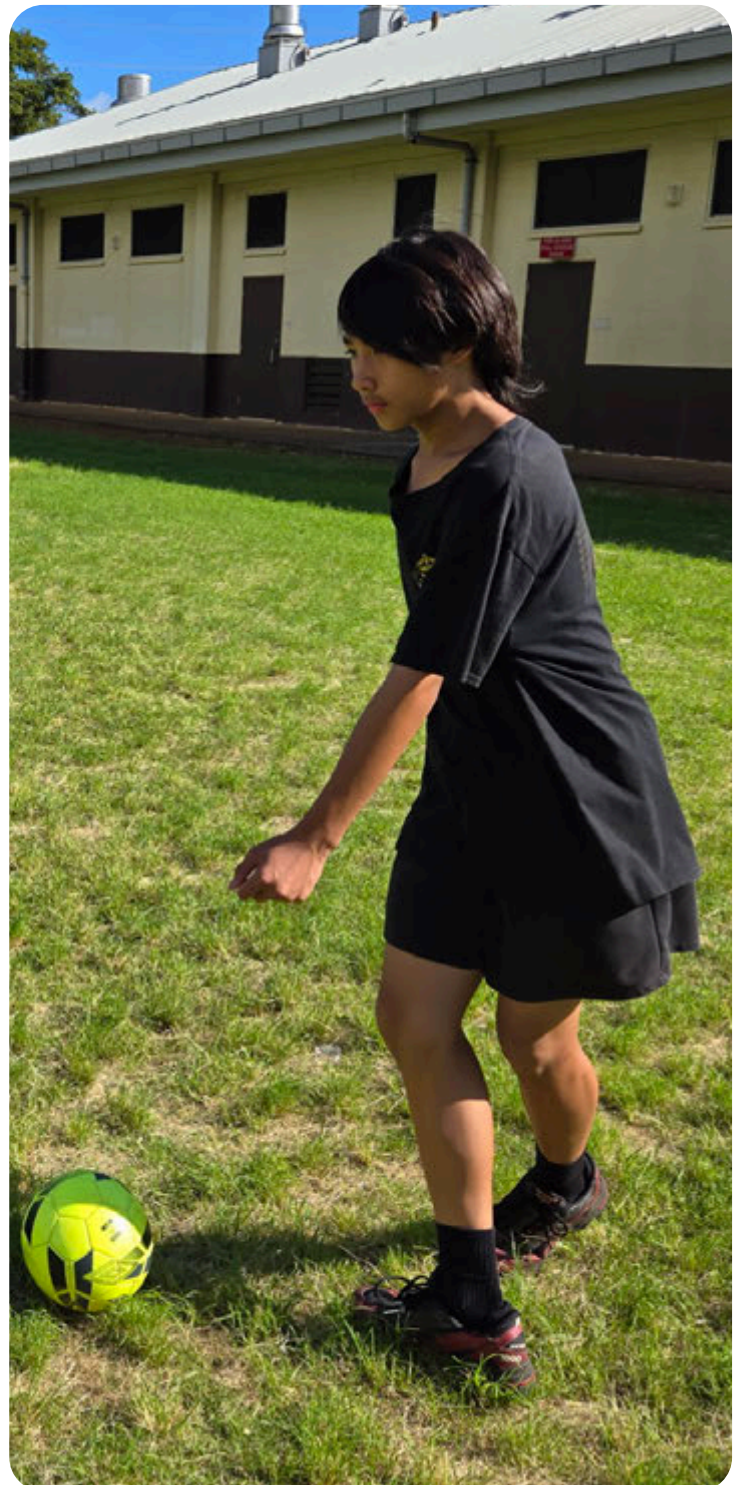
