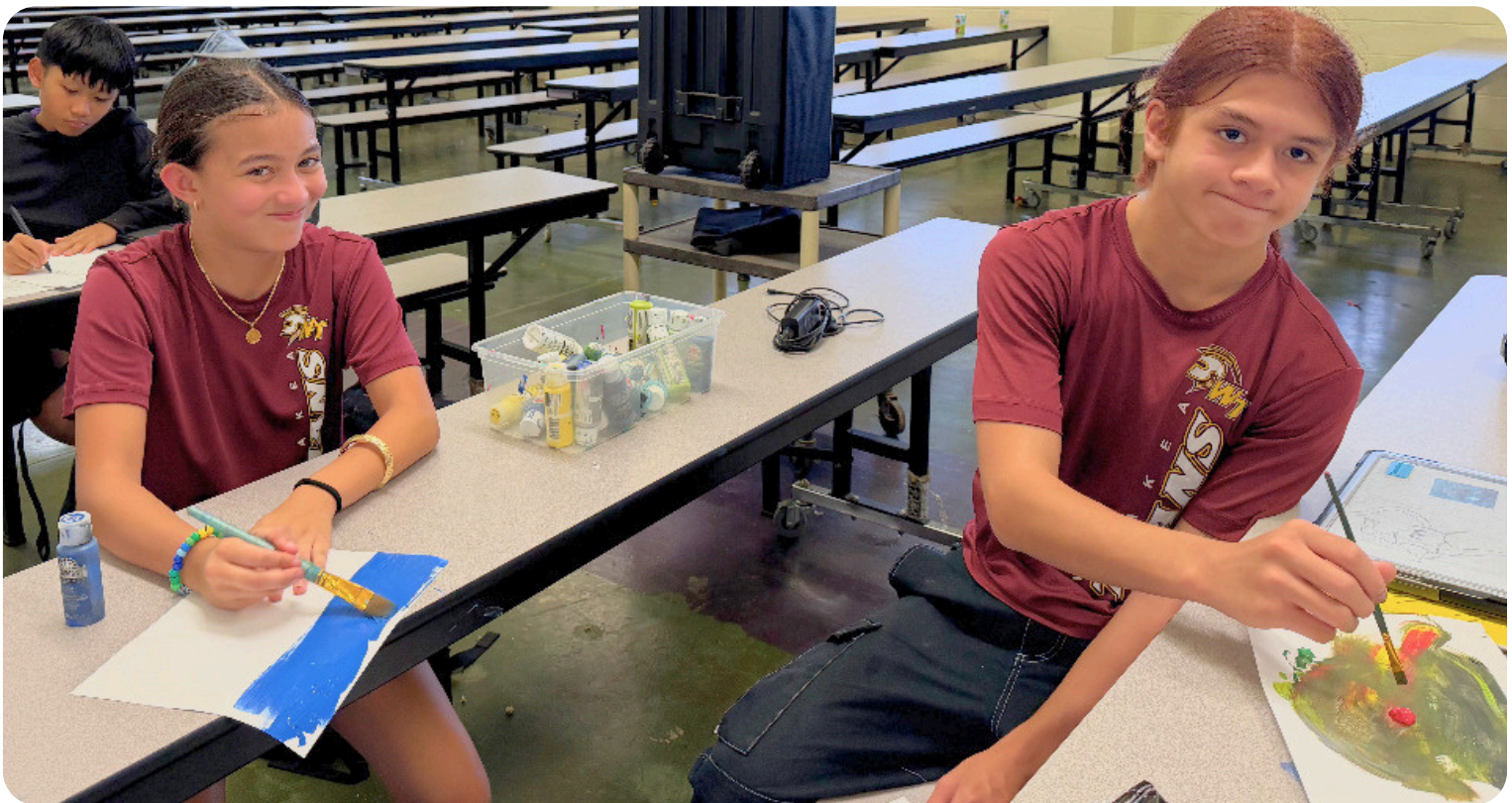


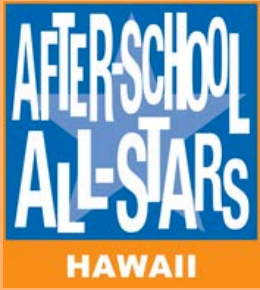

Students build teamwork and persistence while developing fundamental skills such as dribbling, shooting, and defensive play. Participation supports both physical well-being and confidence on and off the court.

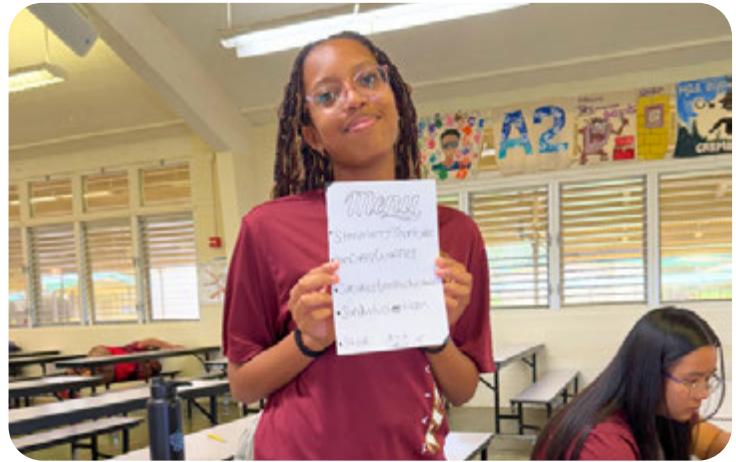




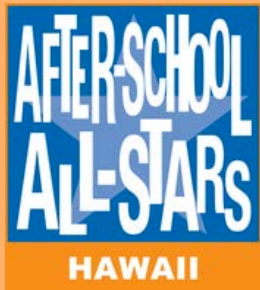

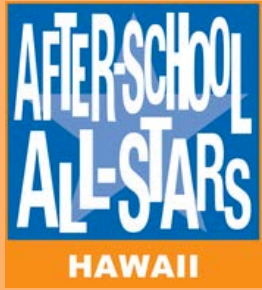


E-SPORTS

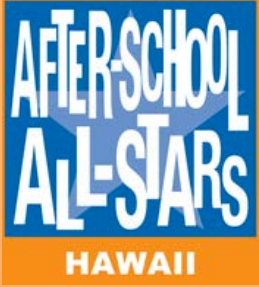

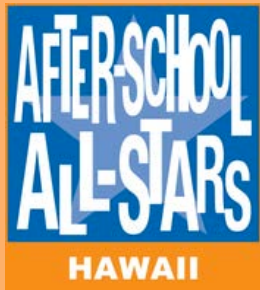


VOLLEYBALL

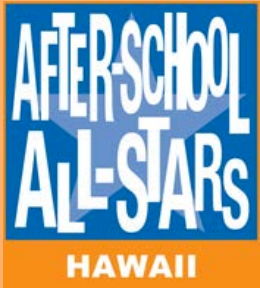

All-Stars students fill their canvases with color and spirit as they experiment with different techniques, brushes and palettes. Students develop creativity, time management, and an understanding of color theory.



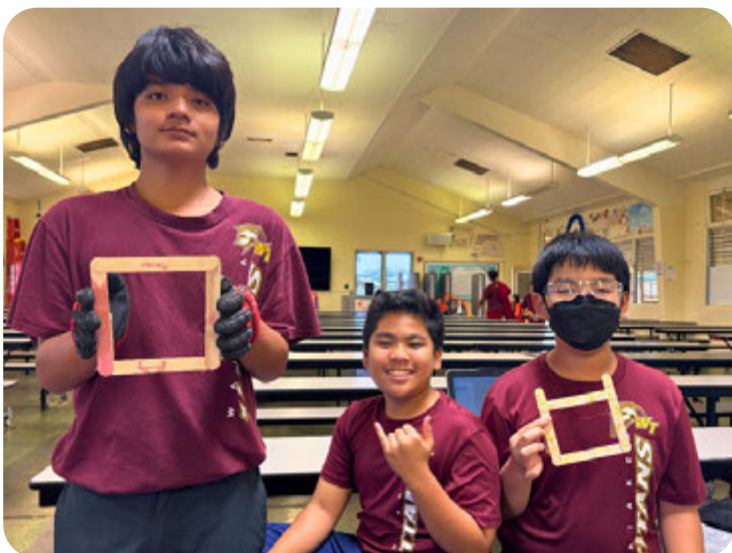

Students engage in hands-on projects such as building picture frames and creating beaded jewelry. These activities strengthen planning, organization, and critical thinking skills.





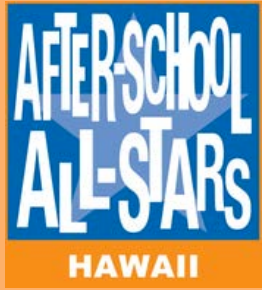
