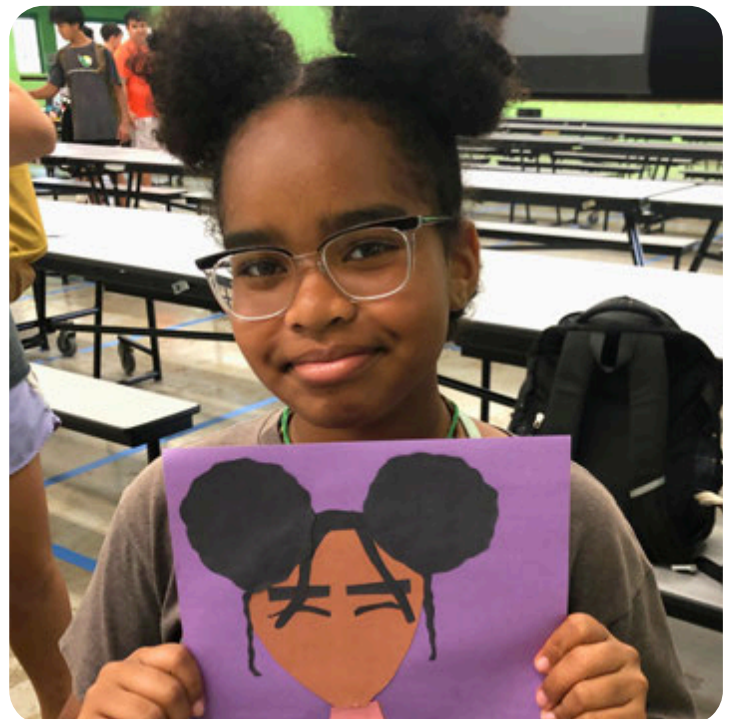
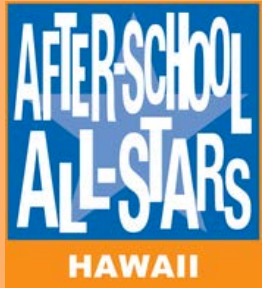

Students create self portraits using construction paper, exploring identity through hands on design. The project encourages creativity while building confidence in artistic expression.



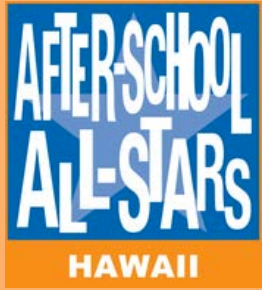

Students learn a new oli and hula each week in preparation for the annual All-Stars Gala. The practice deepens cultural understanding while strengthening discipline and respect.

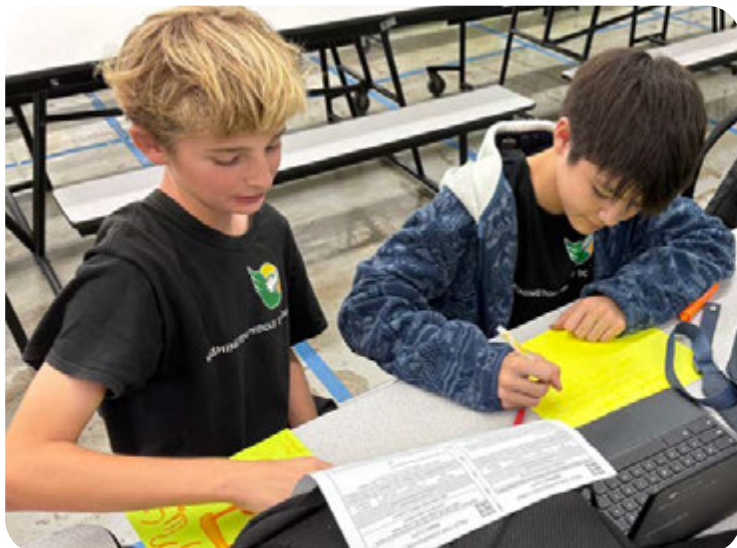


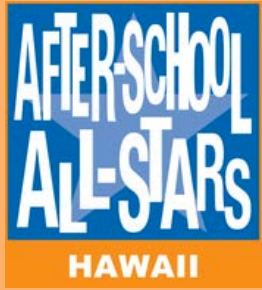

Students explore how art connects to everyday life by creating pieces inspired by their personal experiences. The class encourages observation, reflection, and creative expression.



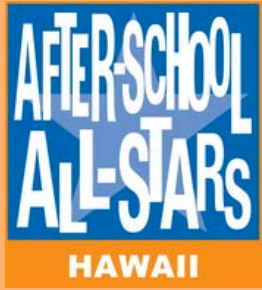

Students practice dribbling techniques and movement patterns to improve overall play. Sessions focus on skill development, control, and consistency.

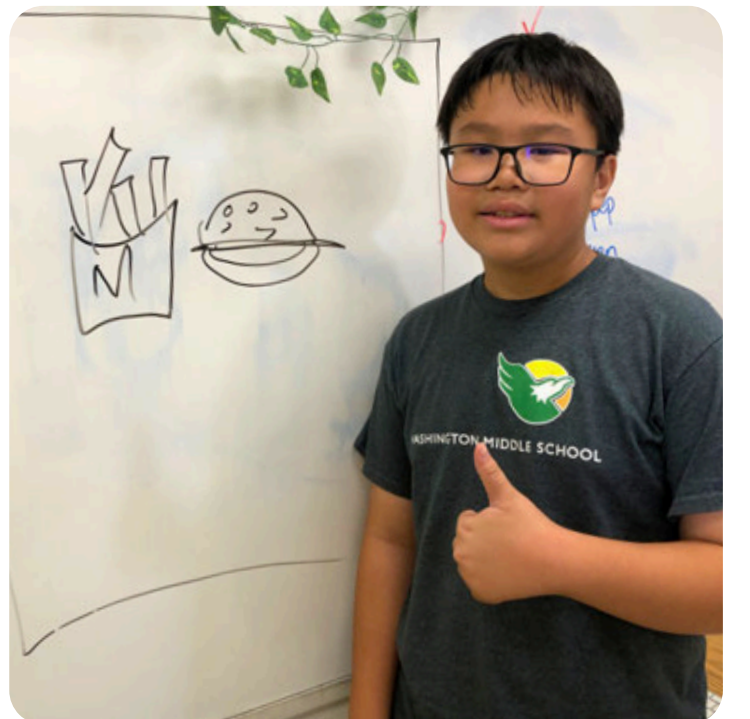


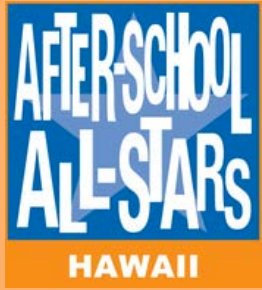

Students learn recipes they can recreate at home while building independence in the kitchen. The class emphasizes practical skills and confidence in preparing meals.



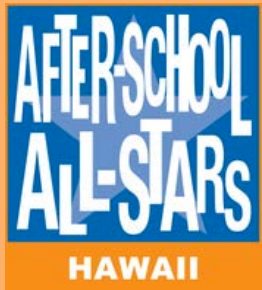

Students prepare for Sports Showdown by developing control and consistency in keeping the ball in play. Practice builds coordination and teamwork.



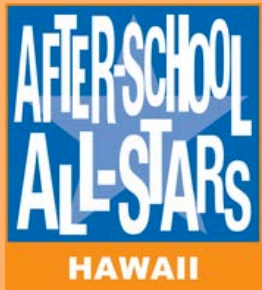

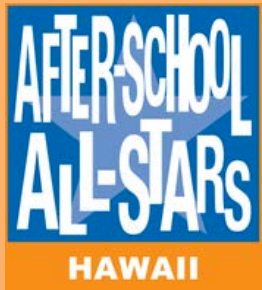

Lead Forward led by Punahou students provides fun activities that unlock leadership potential in youth. All-Stars are flourishing and very eager for future classes.



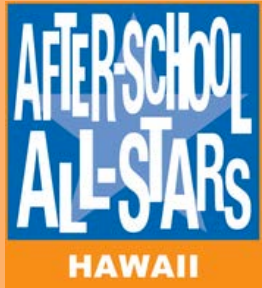
