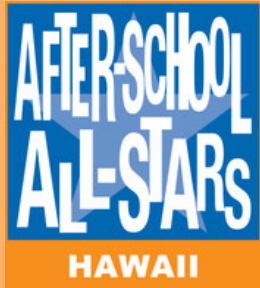


## KEAAU MIDDLE AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS APRIL 2026

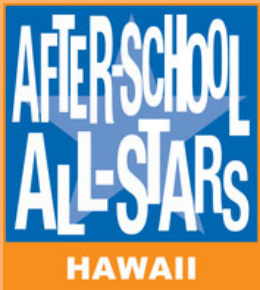

Through each practice, students develop teamwork, communication, and confidence that support both personal and team success.

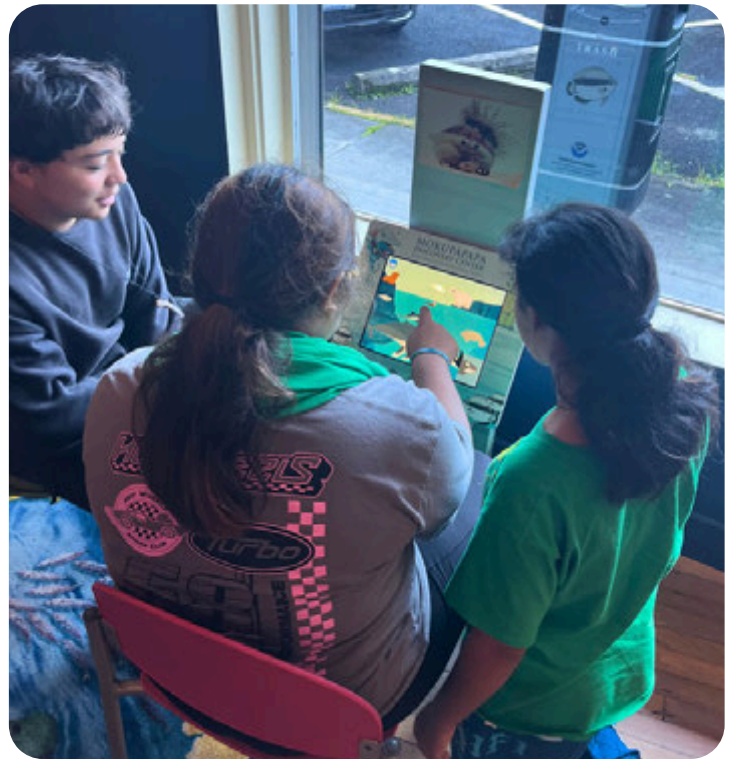


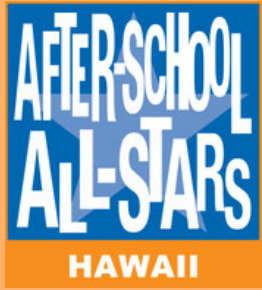


# KEAAU MIDDLE AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS APRIL 2026

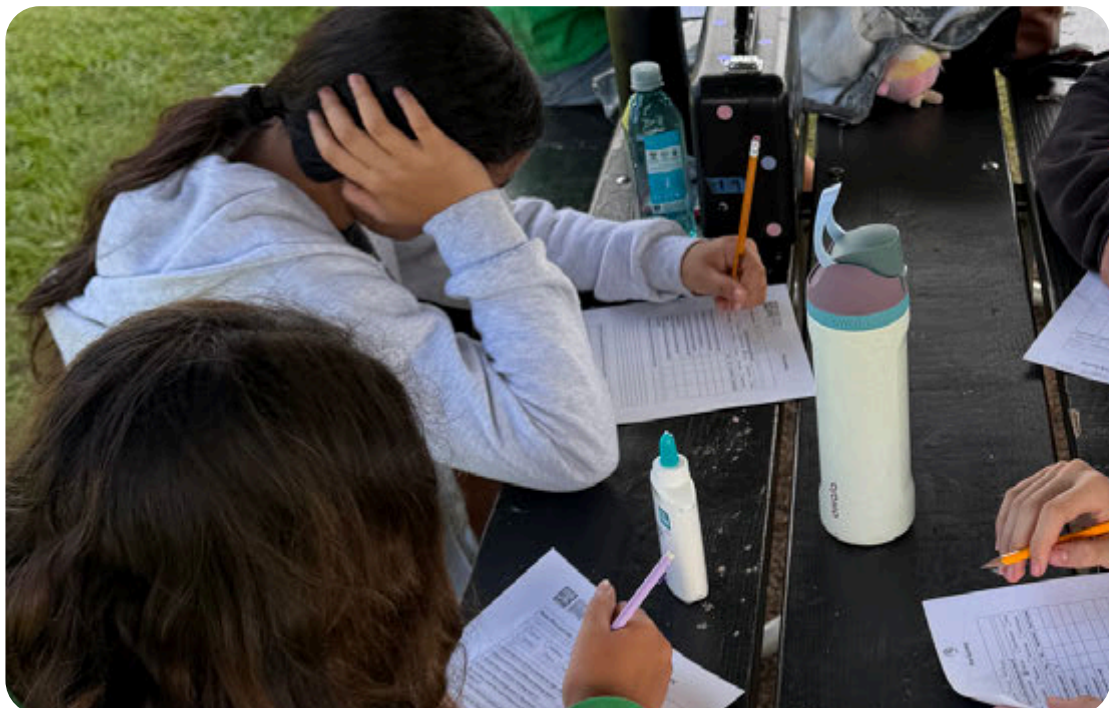


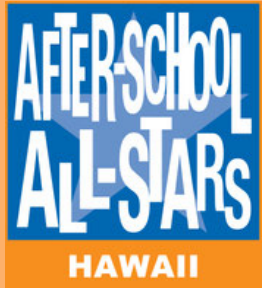

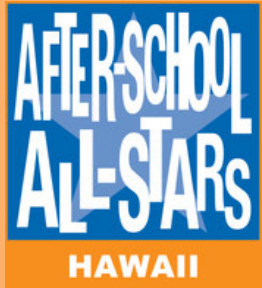

Through each rebound and defensive play, students build confidence, resilience, and collaboration on and off the court.



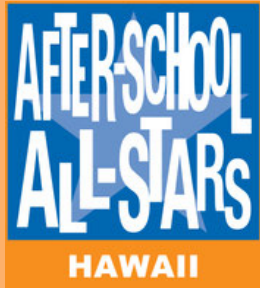

Students enjoy friendly competition in Esports while strengthening their coordination and learning how to think through each move. Moments like these help them grow into adaptable, thoughtful leaders.





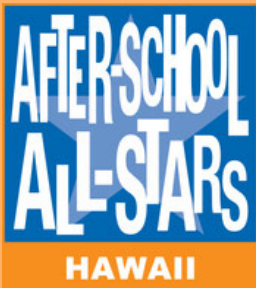
