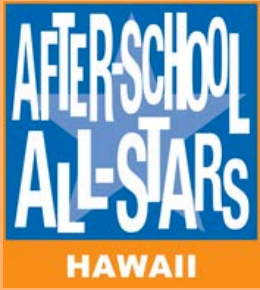


ARTS AND CRAFTS

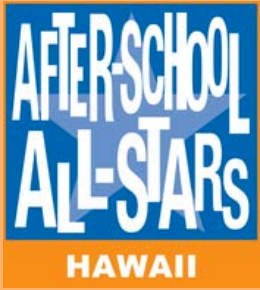
ESPORTS

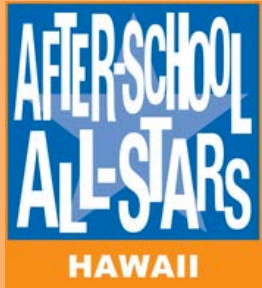

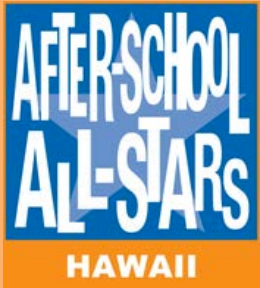
FOOTBALL

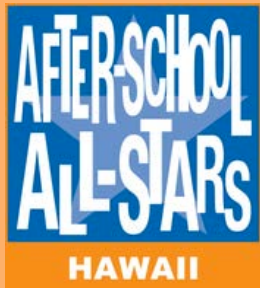


YOUTH CLUB

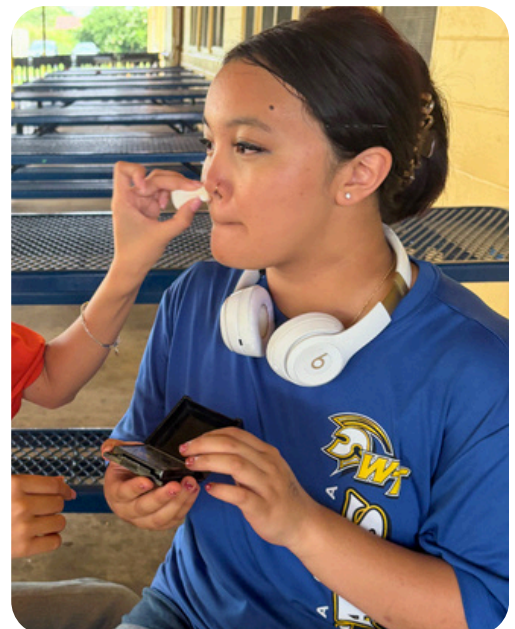


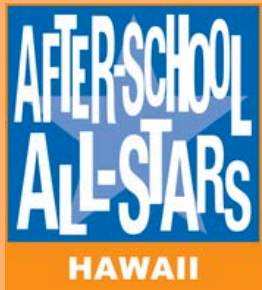

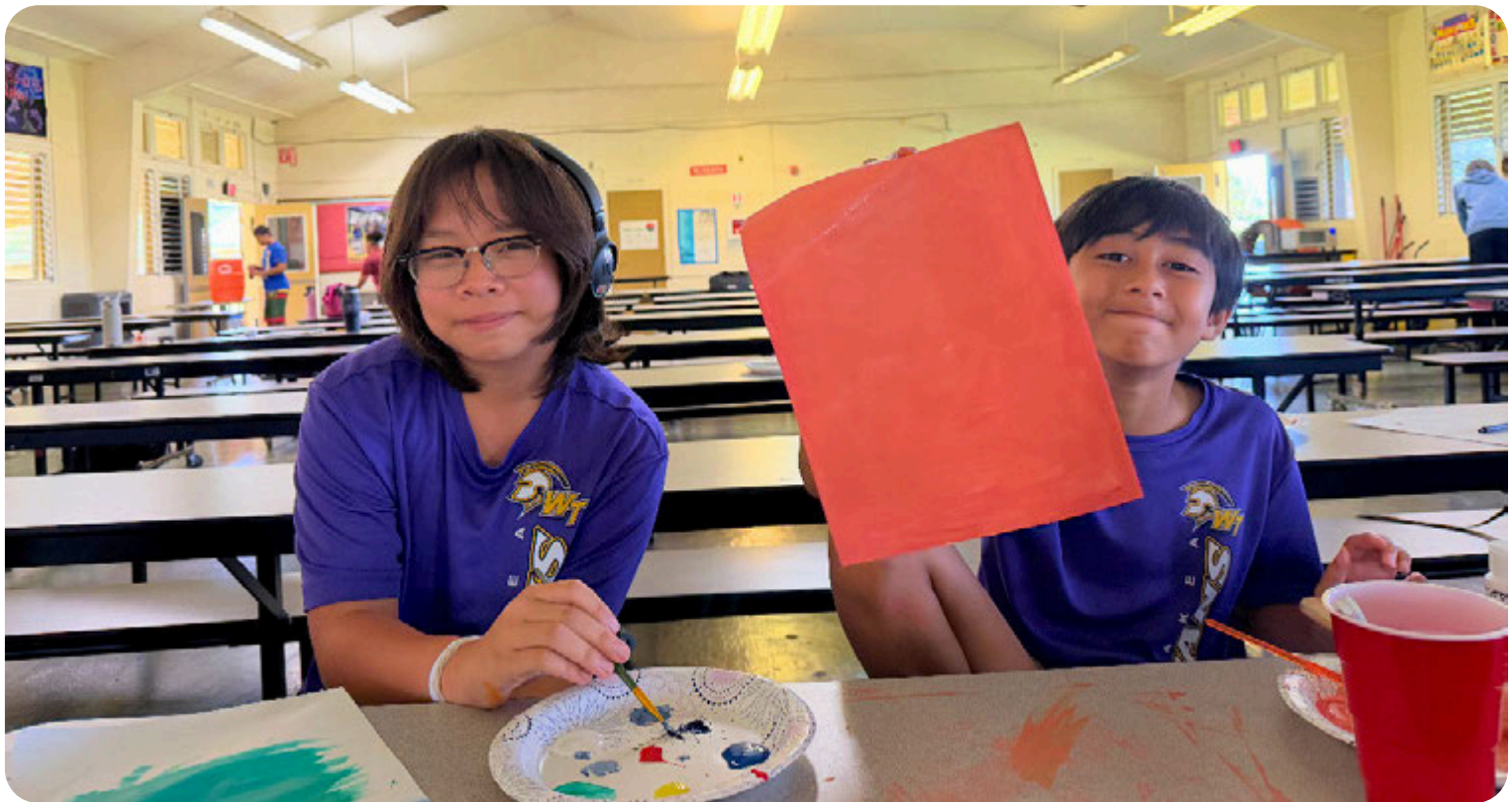

All-Stars students use brushes and sponges to bring their colorful visions to life. By exploring different techniques and materials, students continue to strengthen their creativity and fine motor skills.



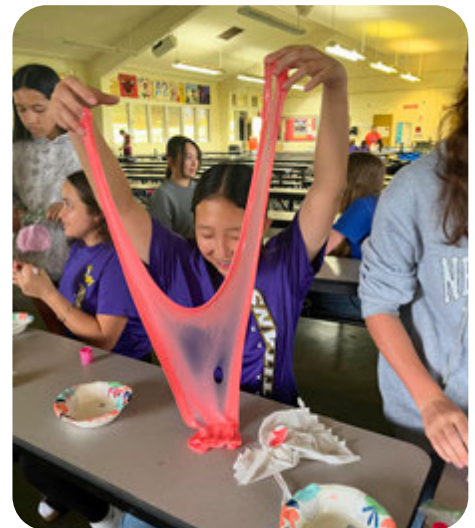
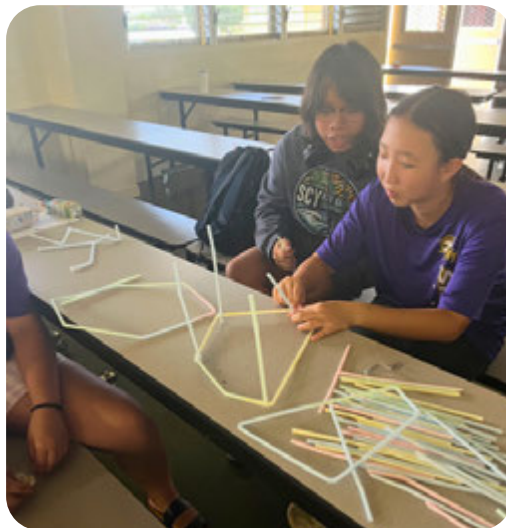

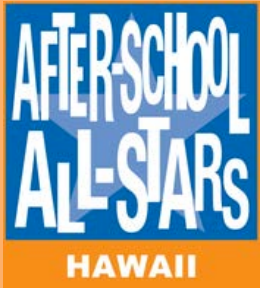
STEM

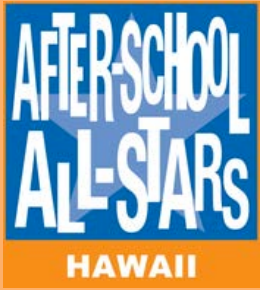
VOLLEYBALL



Volleyball students practice serving, spiking, and teamwork during active sessions on the court. Through each drill and game, students build agility, communication, and confidence while learning to support one another.

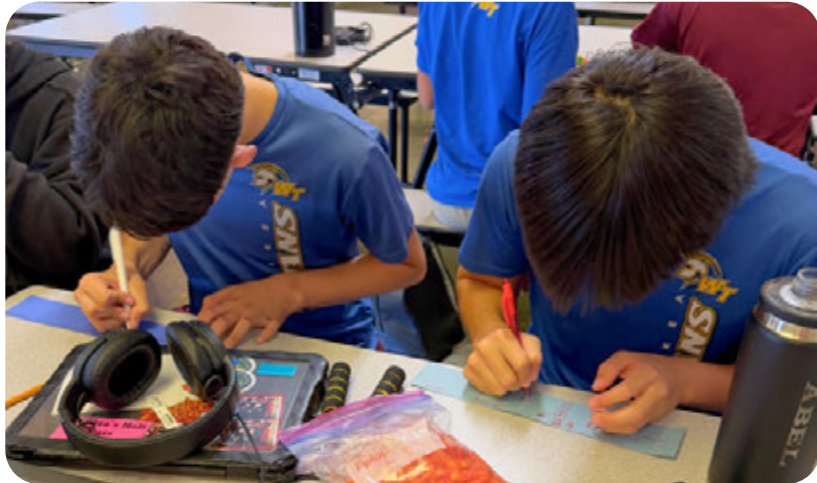
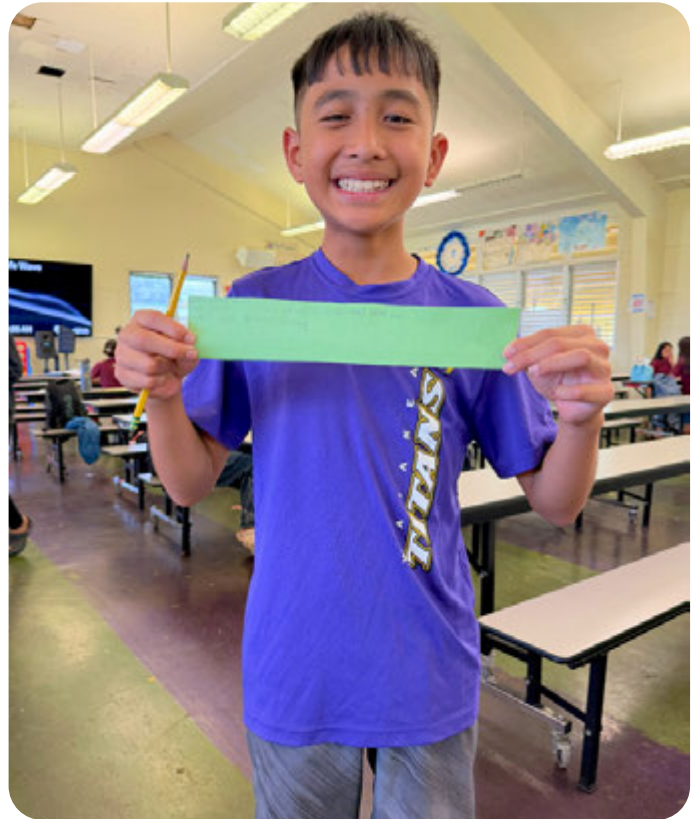

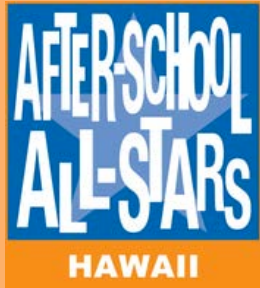
