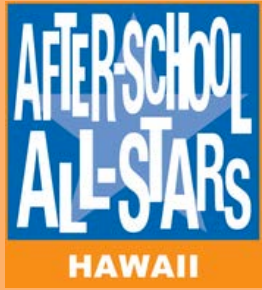


WAIKOLOA MIDDLE AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS APRIL 2026

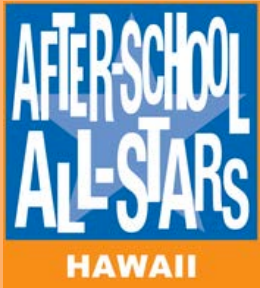


WAIKOLOA MIDDLE AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS APRIL 2026

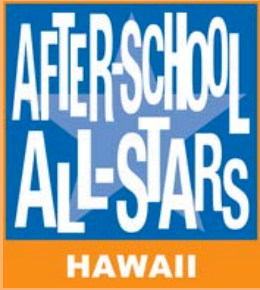

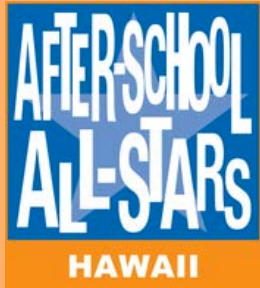

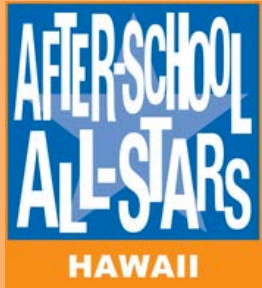


WAIKOLOA MIDDLE AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS APRIL 2026

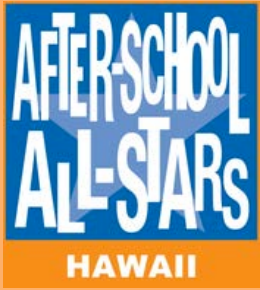


WAIKOLOA MIDDLE AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS APRIL 2026

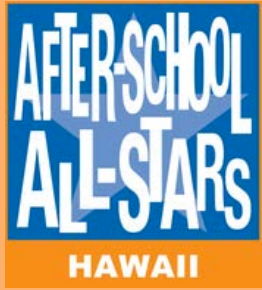

Waikoloa Esports class strengthen teamwork, communication, and strategic thinking. Students discover the value of collaboration and learned that success grows when they support one another.



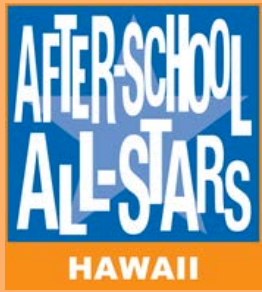


WAIKOLOA MIDDLE AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS APRIL 2026

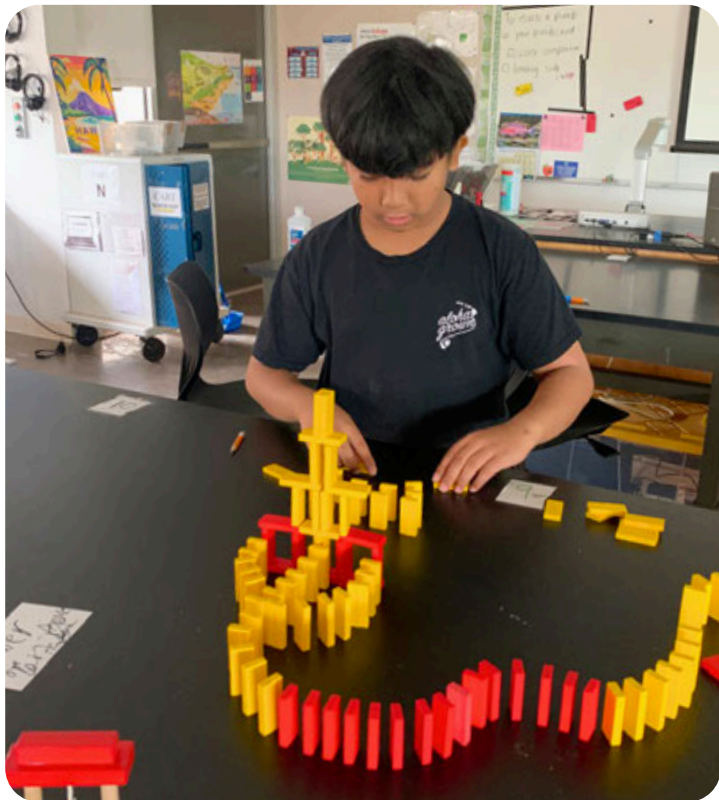


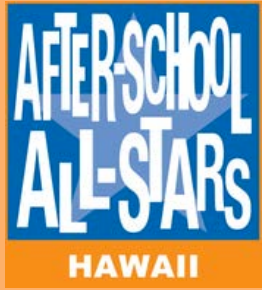


WAIKOLOA MIDDLE AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS APRIL 2026

Students practice ahonui, or patience, while carefully building domino mazes. This activity encourages focus, perseverance, and self-control as students work thoughtfully to complete their maze.

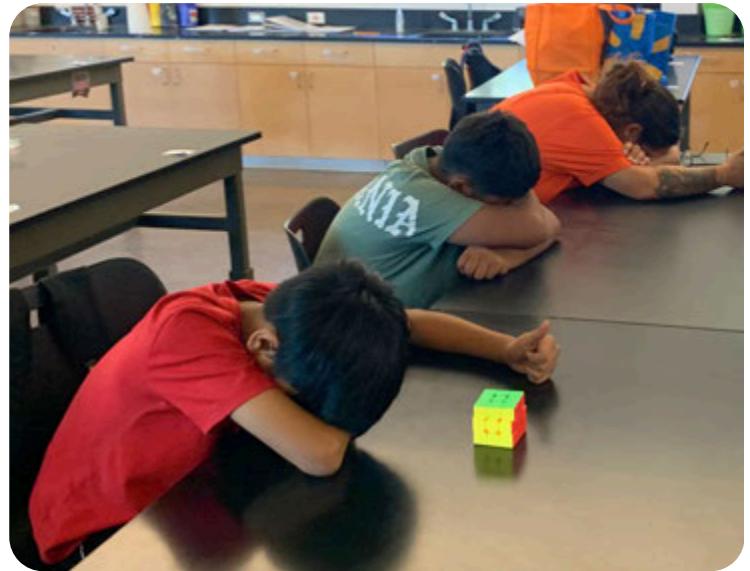


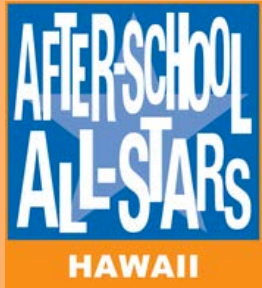
