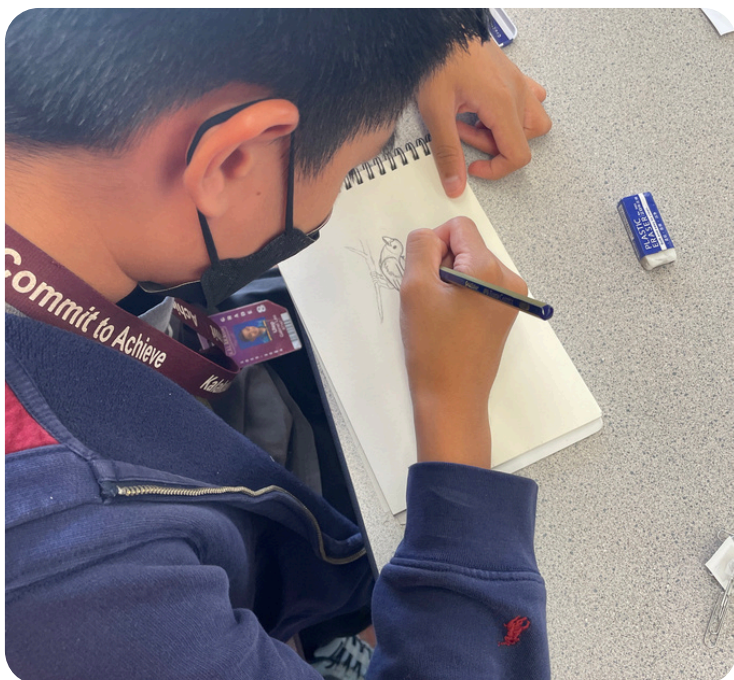
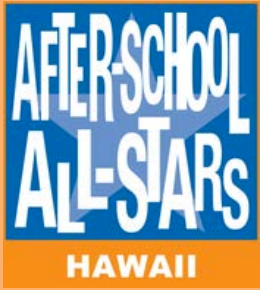


# KALAKAUA MIDDLE SCHOOL AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS MAY 2026

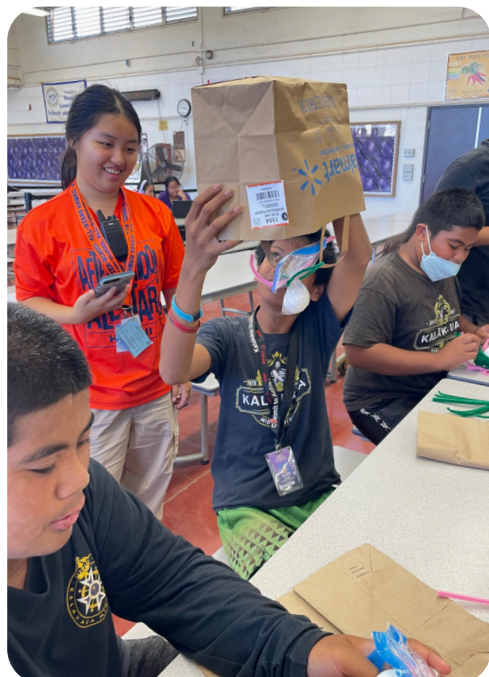


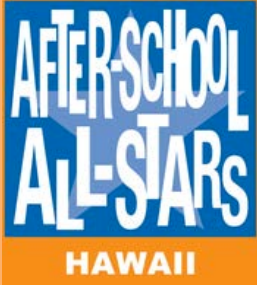


# KALAKAUA MIDDLE SCHOOL AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS MAY 2026

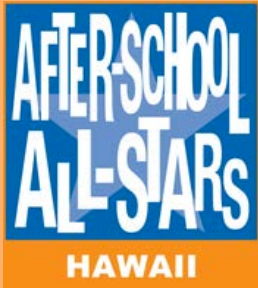


# KALAKAUA MIDDLE SCHOOL AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS MAY 2026
