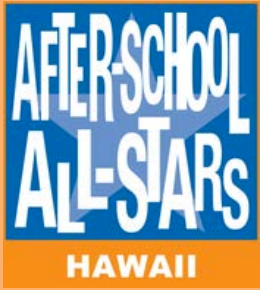


# KEELIKOLANI MIDDLE SCHOOL AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS MAY 2026

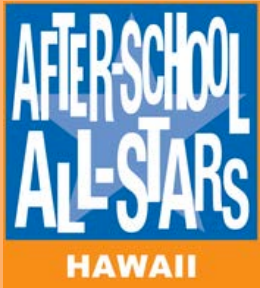


# KEELIKOLANI MIDDLE SCHOOL AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS MAY 2026

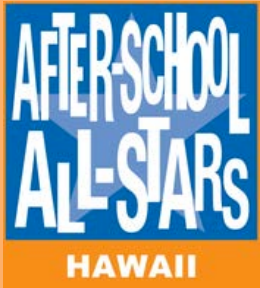


# KEELIKOLANI MIDDLE SCHOOL AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS MAY 2026

The outing provides an opportunity to celebrate their accomplishments, strengthen friendships, and enjoy time together outside of the classroom.



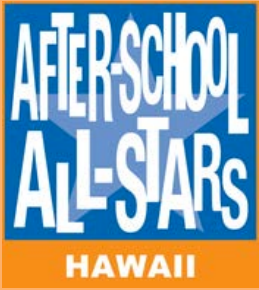

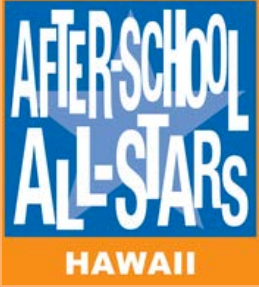
