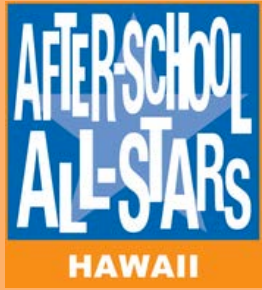


# WASHINGTON MIDDLE AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS MAY 2026

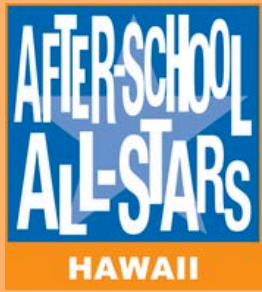


# WASHINGTON MIDDLE AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS APRIL 2026

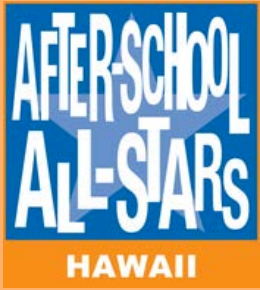


## WASHINGTON MIDDLE AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS MAY 2026

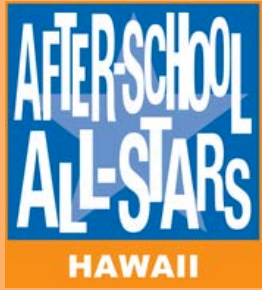


# WASHINGTON MIDDLE AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS APRIL 2026

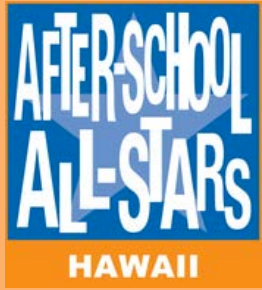

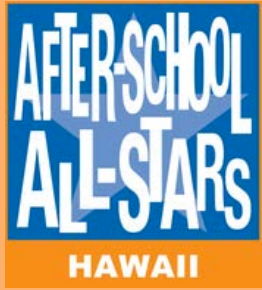


## WASHINGTON MIDDLE AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS APRIL 2026

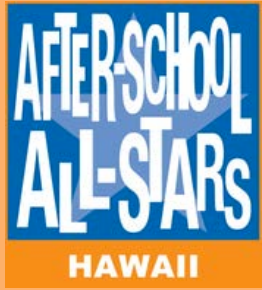

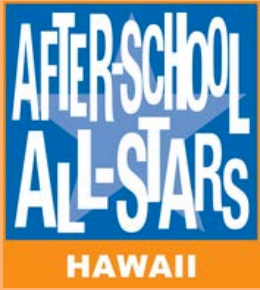
