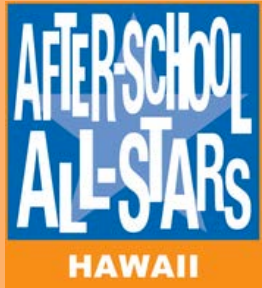

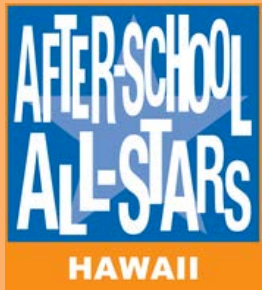
BASKETBALL

Each session helps develop confidence on and off the court.



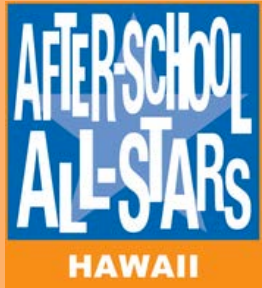

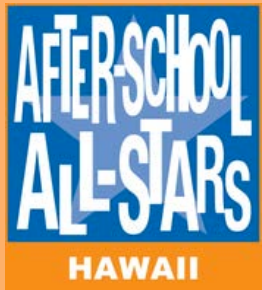

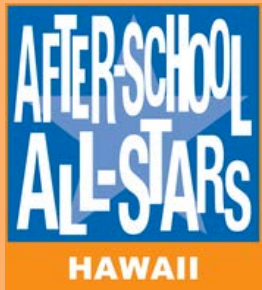

Volleyball students improve their jumping skills and hitting technique through muscle memory drills at the net. By practicing together, they develop coordination, reflexes, teamwork, and communication.



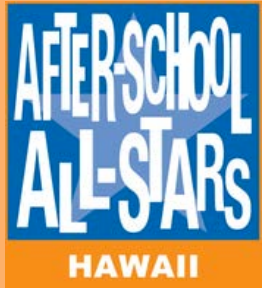

All-Stars fill their canvases with color while experimenting with different painting techniques, brushes, and color palettes. Each project encourages creativity, time management, and an understanding of color theory.





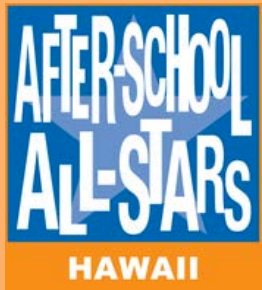
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STEM

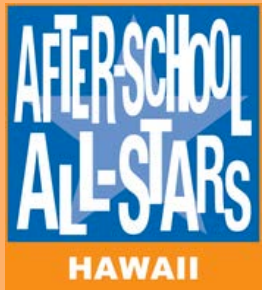
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ARCHERY

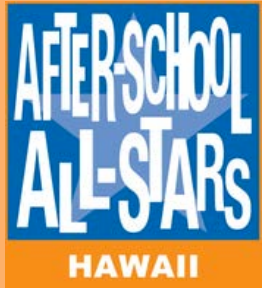


WAIAKEA INTERMEDIATE AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS JULY 2026
