

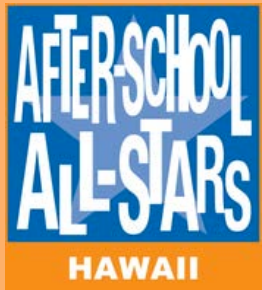
WASHINGTON MIDDLE AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS JUNE 2026

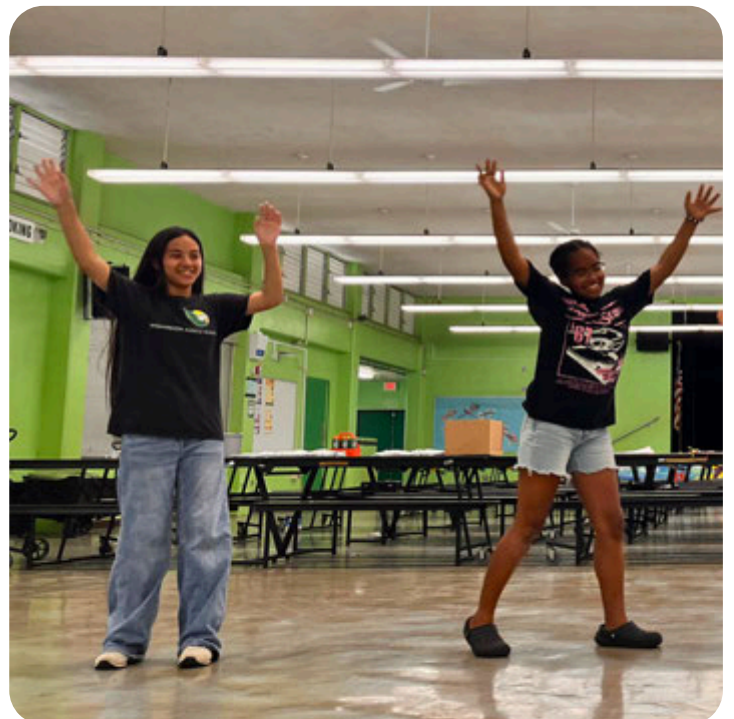


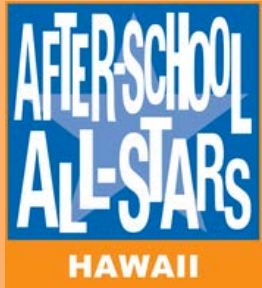


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DANCE

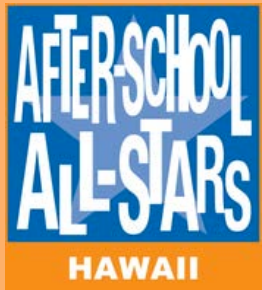


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ARTS AND CRAFTS

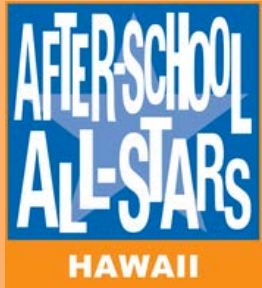


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FIELD TRIP TO THE MOVIE THEATER

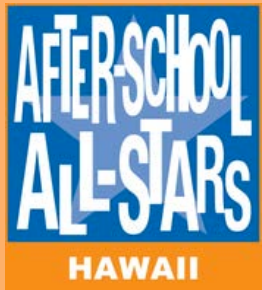


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POLYNESIAN CULTURAL CENTER

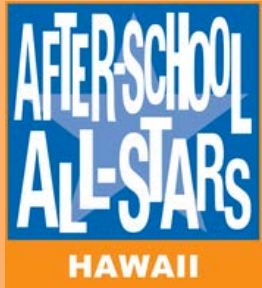


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LIFE SERVICE ACTION: CAMPUS BEAUTIFICATION

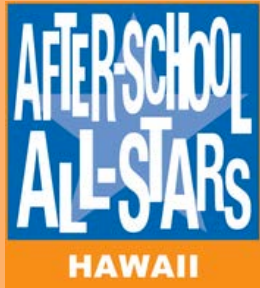


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HAWAIIAN VALUE OF THE WEEK

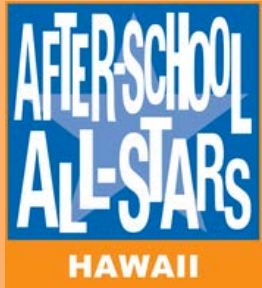


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SOCCKER
