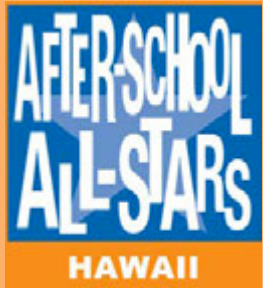


WASHINGTON MIDDLE AFTER-SCHOOL ALL-STARS AUGUST 2026
